make manifest, show (one's) self, manifestly declare, to make manifest or visible or known what has been hidden or unknown, make actual and visible, realised; to be plainly recognized, thoroughly understood: who and what one is

GLORY: doxa {dox'-ah}

Dignity, splendour, brightness, magnificence, excellence, preeminence, majesty; a most glorious condition, most exalted state

JAMES 5:7

care, anxiety

LIFE: biotikos {bee-o-tee-kos'}

things pertaining to this life, pertaining to life and the affairs of this life.
