WORD: logos {log'-os}
Saying, account, speech, a word, uttered by a living voice,
embodies a conception or idea, what is declared, a thought,
declaration, the act of speaking, speech -- the faculty of speech,
skill and practice in speaking

I THESSAI ONIANS 4:16

- 16 For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first:

65 But, to the Church, the Bride, the Rapture is a revelation to
Her. It's revealed to Her. That, the revelation, the true Bride of
Christ will be waiting for that revelation of the Rapture.

Now, it is a revelation, for the revelation is faith. You cannot have a revelation without it being faith. Faith is a revelation, because it's something that's revealed to you. Faith is a revelation.

Faith is something that has been revealed to you, like it was to Abraham, that could call anything contrary to what had been revealed to him, as though it wasn't so. Now, faith, that's what faith is, is the revelation of God. The Church is built upon a revelation, the whole entire Body.

The word of God is comprised of the logos and the rhema word. Both are absolutely essential in furnishing us with the fullness of God's knowledge and will, both as individual believers and corporately in our churches. The logos word defines God in general concepts and ideas to give us the "big picture" of who God is.

The rhema word is a moment-to-moment portion of the logos word uttered by the voice of God's Spirit and "tailored made" to equip us with God's commands, guidance, and the fulfillment of our needs in accordance to our specific circumstances. RHEMA IS LITERALLY THE LIVING VOICE OF GOD.

The word logos comes from the Greek language and it means "word" in general. A longer definition includes thoughts, principles or speech. Anybody can read the Bible to learn about God and his principles and values. They are reading the logos word of God.

Rhema is also translated from Greek into English to mean "word". A rhema word is different from just the written words of the Bible. A Christian may have prayed about a particular issue,

and then while reading his Bible, a particular verse seems to jump out at him in a dramatic way and grabs his attention. He may feel that God is speaking to him personally through that verse at that time.

God has a specific word just so right and needed to help you progress successfully and victoriously through the course of life. It comes to address a specific case right at the time you receive it. Rhema is a 'now' Word! It's the spoken Word from God to you

to effect a specific change in your life.

One Rhema-Word from God can change your life forever. It's that powerful! Rhema sets into motion the power of God as it comes to accomplish and prosper in the things for which it was sent.

I CORINTHIANS 4:20

20 For the kingdom of God is not in word, (LOGOS) but in power.

JAMES 1:18

18 Of his own will begat he us with the word of truth, that we should be a kind of firstfruits of his creatures.

- 6 And saith unto him, If thou be the Son of God, cast thyself down: for it is written, He shall give his angels charge concerning thee: and in their hands they shall bear thee up, lest at any time thou dash thy foot against a stone.
