

READY TO MOVE IN

GENESIS 1:11

11 And God said, Let the earth bring forth grass, the herb yielding seed, and the fruit tree yielding fruit after his kind, whose seed is in itself, upon the earth: and it was so.

12 And the earth brought forth grass, and herb yielding seed after his kind, and the tree yielding fruit, whose seed was in itself, after his kind: and God saw that it was good.

13 And the evening and the morning were the third day.

14 And God said, Let there be lights in the firmament of the heaven to divide the day from the night; and let them be for signs, and for seasons, and for days, and years:

15 And let them be for lights in the firmament of the heaven to give light upon the earth: and it was so.

16 And God made two great lights; the greater light to rule the day, and the lesser light to rule the night: he made the stars also.

17 And God set them in the firmament of the heaven to give light upon the earth,

GENESIS 1:20

20 And God said, Let the waters bring forth *ABUNDANTLY the *MOVING creature that hath life, and fowl that may fly above the earth in the open firmament of heaven.

The waters and the air, separated on the second day, are on this filled with their respective inhabitants. Literally, "Let the waters swarm with swarms of living creatures, and let fowl fly above the earth. " A "swarm" describes a mass of moving living objects on land, in water, or in the air.

animals, small reptiles, quadrupeds

Innumerable millions of animalcula are found in water. Eminent naturalists have discovered not less than 30,000 in a single drop! How inconceivably small must each be, and yet each a perfect animal, furnished with the whole apparatus of bones, muscles, nerves, heart, arteries, veins, lungs, etc.

Others are so small that 500 million of them could live in a dish of water. But the reproduction of fish is another point intended in the text; no creature's are so prolific as these. A Tench will lay 1,000 eggs, a Carp 20,000, and

The row of a codfish contains nine million eggs, of a flounder, about a million and a half, and of a mackerel, half a million. The pigeon of North America has been seen in flocks a mile wide, and taking four hours in passing, at the rate of a mile a minute, and was calculated to contain 250 million birds.

GENESIS 1:20

20 And God said, Let the waters bring forth abundantly the moving creature that hath life, and fowl that may fly above the earth in the open firmament of heaven.

There are about 1,250,000 identified species of animals. This includes 1,190,200 invertebrates, among them 950,000 insects, 70,000 mollusks, 40,000 crustaceans, and 130,200 others.

There are about 58,800 identified vertebrates, including 29,300 fish, 5,743 amphibians, 8,240 reptiles, 9,800 birds, and 5,416 mammals. As a comparison, almost 300,000 plant species are known.

Importantly, the numbers above do not account for species which have not yet been captured or described scientifically.

Scientists estimate there may be as many as 30 million unidentified insect species, many of them living in the rainforest, and up to 1 million mite species.

Mites are small arthropods, a group of animals related to but not the same as insects.

GENESIS 1:21

21 And God created great whales, and every living creature that moveth, which the waters brought forth abundantly, after their kind, and every winged fowl after his kind: and God saw that it was good.

And God created great whales, in the original it's not just one specie but it's comprising all the great aquatic animals, such as the various species of whales, the porpoise, the dolphin, the or narwal, and the shark.

God delights to show himself in little as well as in great things: hence he forms animals so minute that 30,000 can be contained in one drop of water; and others like the blue whale. They reach lengths up to about 100 feet and weights of an amazing 100-150 tons.

PSALM 104:24

24 O LORD, how manifold are thy works! in wisdom hast thou made them all: the earth is full of thy riches.

25 So is this great and wide sea, wherein are things creeping innumerable, both small and great beasts.

26 There go the ships: there is that leviathan, whom thou hast made to play therein.

27 These wait all upon thee; that thou mayest give them their meat in due season.

28 That thou givest them they gather: thou openest thine hand, they are filled with good.

29 Thou hidest thy face, they are troubled: thou takest away their breath, they die, and return to their dust.

30 Thou sendest forth thy spirit, they are created: and thou renewest the face of the earth.

INSECTS: -- On the fifth day were also produced the insect population of the new-made world, for these, as well as birds, must be included in the term winged thing. Insects are by far the most numerous and diversified of all the living orders that occupy the dry land. About one million species of insects have been identified so far.

GENESIS 1:22

22 And God blessed them, saying, Be fruitful, and multiply, and fill the waters in the seas, and let fowl multiply in the earth.

"Creature," Heb. nephesh, implies self-conscious life, as distinguished from plants, which have unconscious life.

19 For that which befalleth the sons of men befalleth beasts; even one thing befalleth them: as the one dieth, so dieth the other; yea, they have all one breath; so that a man hath no preeminence above a beast: for all is vanity.

20 All go unto one place; all are of the dust, and all turn to dust again.

21 Who knoweth the spirit of man that goeth upward, and the spirit of the beast that goeth downward to the earth?

GENESIS 1:24

24 And God said, Let the earth bring forth the living creature after his kind, cattle, and creeping thing, and beast of the earth after his kind: and it was so.

And God said, Let the earth bring forth the living creature after his kind. In these words the land animals are generically characterized as *nephesh chayyah*, or animated beings; in the terms which follow they are subdivided into three well-defined species or classes.

Cattle. *Behemah*; literally, the dumb animal, *i. e.* the larger grass-eating quadrupeds. And creeping thing. *Remes*; the moving animal, *i. e.* the smaller animals that move either without feet or with feet that are scarcely perceptible, such as worms, insects, reptiles.

Here it is land-creepers that are meant, the *remes* of the sea having been created on the previous day. And beast of the earth (*chayyah* of the earth) after his kind. beasts of the forests and fields.

GENESIS 1:25

25 And God made the beast of the earth after his kind, and cattle after their kind, and everything that creepeth upon the earth after his kind: and God saw that it was good.

GENESIS 1:26

26 And God said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness: and let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over the cattle, and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth.

13-13 What connection does this Genesis 1:26 have with Genesis 2:7? God created two men. And which was the man, and which. . . What connection does that have? What. . . How does it connect up in the Scripture?

Well now, if you'll notice close now, in Genesis 1:26, let's get the first part first. God said, "Let us. . . " Now, "let us," us is a. . . "Let us make man in our own image. " Our, 'course, we realize He's talking to someone; He was speaking to another being. "Let us make man in our own image after our likeness, and let them have dominion over the cattles of the field. "If you notice in creation, the first thing that was created, of course, was light. You come on down through the creation; the last thing was created was what? A man.

And woman was made after man. All right, the first. . . Last thing that was created of God's creation is mankind. But when God made His first man, if you noticed, He made him in the likeness of Himself; He was made in the image of God.

14-21 Now, if God created man in His Own image and in His Own likeness, what kind of a man did He create? A spirit man.

Now, if you'll notice, after He had made all the creation and created a spirit man (the close reading of this now, to the one that asked the question will find this), that God give dominion of the cattle and the fishes and everything to the man.

But in His making up there, He made man in His Own image to lead the cattle, lead the beasts of the field, just like the Holy Spirit leads the believer today. See? He was, in other words, Adam, the first man in the lower creations of God. . . .

The first creation was God Himself; then out of God came the Logos, which was the Son of God; then out of the Logos, which was the Word ("In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. It could not be seen (which is a spiritual Being). He manifested or unfolded Himself a little more to make a trinity of Himself by Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. And here was God, unfolded Himself now,

down into "let us make man (which was His son, an offspring from Him) man in Our own image (He was a supernatural being.), and let him have dominion over the cattles of the field, and so forth. "Now, the man led the man--led the--the cattle and everything,

just like the Holy Spirit leads a real true believer today. The Voice of God out there. . . . The voice of man, rather, would speak and say. . . . call the cattle this way, call the sheep over to this pasture, call the fishes to this water. See, he had dominion; everything obeyed him.
