13 ¶ Let no man say when he is tempted, I am tempted of God: for God cannot be tempted with evil, **neither tempteth he any man**:

### **EXODUS 33:11**

11 And the LORD spake unto Moses face to face, as a man speaketh unto his friend. And he turned again into the camp: but

his servant Joshua, the son of Nun, a young man, departed not out of the tabernacle.

### **JOHN 1:18**

18 No man hath seen God at any time; the only begotten Son, which is in the bosom of the Father, he hath declared him.

### **I JOHN 4:12**

12 No man hath seen God at any time. If we love one another, God dwelleth in us, and his love is perfected in us.

### **THE AGE OF KING AHAZIAH WHEN HE BEGAN HIS REIGN**

#### **II KINGS 8:26**

26 **Two and twenty years old** was Ahaziah when he began to reign; and he reigned one year in Jerusalem. And his mother's name was Athaliah, the daughter of Omri king of Israel.

#### **II CHRONICLES 22:2**

2 **Forty and two years old** was Ahaziah when he began to reign, and he reigned one year in Jerusalem. His mother's name also was Athaliah the daughter of Omri.

### **HOW OLD WAS JEHOIACHIN WHEN HE BEGAN TO REIGN?**

#### **II KINGS 24:8**

8 ¶ Jehoiachin was **eighteen years old** when he began to reign, and he reigned in Jerusalem three months. And his mother's name was Nehushta, the daughter of Elnathan of Jerusalem.

#### **II CHRONICLES 36:9**

9 Jehoiachin was **eight years old** when he began to reign, and he reigned three months and ten days in Jerusalem: and he did that which was evil in the sight of the LORD.

### **THE AMOUNT OF SUPERVISORS FOR SOLOMON'S TEMPLE PROJECT**

### **I KINGS 9:23**

23 These were the chief of the officers that were over Solomon's work, **five hundred and fifty**, which bare rule over the people that wrought in the work.

### **II CHRONICLES 8:10**

10 And these were the chief of king Solomon's officers, even **two hundred and fifty**, that bare rule over the people.

### **JACOB BOUGHT A SEPULCHRE FROM HAMOR**

#### **JOSHUA 24:32**

32 And the bones of Joseph, which the children of Israel brought up out of Egypt, buried they in Shechem, in a parcel of ground **which Jacob bought** of the sons of Hamor the father of Shechem for an hundred pieces of silver: and it became the inheritance of the children of Joseph.

### **ABRAHAM BOUGHT IT OF HAMOR**

#### **ACTS 7:15**

15 So Jacob went down into Egypt, and died, he, and our fathers,

#### **ACTS 7:16**

16 And were carried over into Sychem, and laid in the sepulchre **that Abraham bought** for a sum of money of the sons of **Emmor** the father of Sychem.

### **HOW MANY SONS DID JESSE HAVE?**

#### **I SAMUEL 17:12**

12 ¶ Now David was the son of that Ephrathite of Bethlehemjudah, whose name was Jesse; and **he had eight sons**: and the man went among men for an old man in the days of Saul.

**I CHRONICLES 2:13**

13 And Jesse begat his firstborn Eliab, and Abinadab the second, and Shimma the third,

**I CHRONICLES 2:14**

14 Nethaneel the fourth, Raddai the fifth,

**I CHRONICLES 2:15**

15 Ozem the sixth, David the seventh:

**DAVID WAS TEMPTED BY THE LORD TO NUMBER ISRAEL**

**II SAMUEL 24:1**

1 ¶ And again the anger of the LORD was kindled against Israel, and he moved David against them to say, Go, number Israel and Judah.

**DAVID WAS TEMPTED BY SATAN TO NUMBER THE PEOPLE**

**I CHRONICLES 21:1**

1 ¶ And Satan stood up against Israel, and provoked David to number Israel.

**THE NUMBER OF FIGHTING MEN OF ISRAEL WAS 800,000; AND OF JUDAH 500,000**

## **II SAMUEL 24:9**

9 And Joab gave up the sum of the number of the people unto the king: and there were in Israel **eight hundred thousand** valiant men that drew the sword; and the men of Judah were **five hundred thousand** men.

## **THE NUMBER OF FIGHTING MEN OF ISRAEL WAS 1,100,000; AND OF JUDAH 470,000**

## **I CHRONICLES 21:5**

5 And Joab gave the sum of the number of the people unto David. And all they of Israel were a thousand thousand and an hundred thousand men that drew sword: and Judah was four hundred threescore and ten thousand men that drew sword.

## **DAVID BOUGHT A THRESHING FLOOR FOR FIFTY SHEKELS OF SILVER**

## **II SAMUEL 24:24**

24 And the king said unto Araunah, Nay; but I will surely buy it of thee at a price: neither will I offer burnt offerings unto the LORD my God of that which doth cost me nothing. So David bought the threshingfloor and the oxen **for fifty shekels of silver**.

## **DAVID BOUGHT THE THRESHING FLOOR FOR SIX HUNDRED SHEKELS OF GOLD**

## **I CHRONICLES 21:25**

25 So David gave to Ornan for the place **six hundred shekels of gold** by weight.

## **WAS IT THREE OR SEVEN YEARS FAMINE?**

## **II SAMUEL 24:13**

13 So Gad came to David, and told him, and said unto him, **Shall seven years of famine** come unto thee in thy land? or wilt thou flee three months before thine enemies, while they pursue thee? or that there be three days' pestilence in thy land?

now advise, and see what answer I shall return to him that sent me.

### **I CHRONICLES 21:12**

12 **Either three years' famine;** or three months to be destroyed before thy foes, while that the sword of thine enemies overtaketh thee; or else three days the sword of the LORD, even the pestilence, in the land, and the angel of the LORD destroying throughout all the coasts of Israel. Now therefore advise thyself what word I shall bring again to him that sent me.

### **DID MICHAL SAUL'S DAUGHTER HAVE ANY CHILDREN?**

#### **II SAMUEL 6:23**

23 Therefore Michal the daughter of Saul **had no child unto the day of her death.**

#### **II SAMUEL 21:8**

8 But the king took the two sons of Rizpah the daughter of Aiah, whom she bare unto Saul, Armoni and Mephibosheth; and **the five sons of Michal the daughter of Saul**, whom she brought up for Adriel the son of Barzillai the Meholathite:

### **DID ABSALOM HAVE CHILDREN?**

#### **II SAMUEL 14:27**

27 And unto Absalom there were **born three sons, and one daughter**, whose name was Tamar: she was a woman of a fair countenance.

#### **II SAMUEL 18:18**

18 Now Absalom in his lifetime had taken and reared up for himself a pillar, which is in the king's dale: for he said, **I have no son to keep my name in remembrance:** and he called the pillar after his own name: and it is called unto this day, Absalom's place.

### **HOW MANY STALLS DID SOLOMON HAVE?**

### **I KINGS 4:26**

26 And Solomon had **forty thousand** stalls of horses for his chariots, and twelve thousand horsemen.

### **II CHRONICLES 9:25**

25 And Solomon had **four thousand** stalls for horses and chariots, and twelve thousand horsemen; whom he bestowed in the chariot cities, and with the king at Jerusalem.

### **THE AMOUNT OF GOLD TALENTS SOLOMON RECEIVED**

### **I KINGS 9:28**

28 And they came to Ophir, and fetched from thence gold, **four hundred and twenty talents**, and brought it to king Solomon.

### **II CHRONICLES 8:18**

18 And Hiram sent him by the hands of his servants ships, and servants that had knowledge of the sea; and they went with the servants of Solomon to Ophir, and took thence **four hundred and fifty talents of gold**, and brought them to king Solomon.

### **THE AMOUNT OF CHARIOTEERS KILLED BY DAVID**

### **II SAMUEL 10:18**

18 And the Syrians fled before Israel; and David slew the men of **seven hundred chariots** of the Syrians, and forty thousand horsemen, and smote Shobach the captain of their host, who died there.

### **I CHRONICLES 19:18**

18 But the Syrians fled before Israel; and David slew of the Syrians **seven thousand men** which fought in chariots, and forty thousand footmen, and killed Shophach the captain of the host.

## **WHO IS THE FATHER OF JOSEPH**

### **MATTHEW 1:16**

16 And **Jacob** begat Joseph the husband of Mary, of whom was born Jesus, who is called Christ.

### **MARK 1:11**

### **MARK 1:12**

12 And **immediately the Spirit driveth him into the wilderness.**

## **BUT JOHN SAYS**

### **JOHN 1:32**

32 And John bare record, saying, I saw the Spirit descending from heaven like a dove, and it abode upon him.

### **JOHN 1:33**

33 And I knew him not: but he that sent me to baptize with water, the same said unto me, Upon whom thou shalt see the Spirit descending, and remaining on him, the same is he which baptizeth with the Holy Ghost.

### **JOHN 1:34**

34 And I saw, and bare record that this is the Son of God.

### **JOHN 1:35**



35 Again **the next day** after John stood, and two of his disciples;

### **JOHN 1:36**

36 And looking upon Jesus as he walked, he saith, Behold the Lamb of God!

### **JOHN THE BAPTIST WAS ELIAS**

### **MATTHEW 11:13**

13 For all the prophets and the law prophesied until John.

### **MATTHEW 11:14**

14 And if ye will receive it, **this is Elias**, which was for to come.

### **JOHN THE BAPTIST WAS NOT ELIAS**

### **JOHN 1:20**

20 And he confessed, and denied not; but confessed, I am not the Christ.

### **JOHN 1:21**

21 And they asked him, What then? **Art thou Elias?** And he saith, I am not. Art thou that prophet? And he answered, **No.**

### **A WOMAN OF CANAAN BESOUGHT JESUS**

### **MATTHEW 15:22**

22 And, behold, a woman of Canaan came out of the same coasts, and cried unto him, saying, Have mercy on me, O Lord, thou Son of David; my daughter is grievously vexed with a devil.

### **IT WAS A GREEK WOMAN WHO BESOUGHT HIM**

### **MARK 7:25**

25 For a certain woman, whose young daughter had an unclean spirit, heard of him, and came and fell at his feet:

### **MARK 7:26**

26 The woman was a Greek, a Syrophenician by nation; and she besought him that he would cast forth the devil out of her daughter.

### **ELIJAH WENT UP TO HEAVEN**

#### **II KINGS 2:11**

11 And it came to pass, as they still went on, and talked, that, behold, there appeared a chariot of fire, and horses of fire, and parted them both asunder; and Elijah went up by a whirlwind into heaven.

### **AND SO DID ENOCH**

### **NONE BUT CHRIST EVER ASCENDED INTO HEAVEN**

#### **JOHN 3:13**

13 And no man hath ascended up to heaven, but he that came down from heaven, even the Son of man which is in heaven.

### **WHO PROPHESED OF THE POTTER'S FIELD?**

#### **MATTHEW 27:7**

7 And they took counsel, and bought with them the potter's field, to bury strangers in.

#### **MATTHEW 27:8**

8 Wherefore that field was called, The field of blood, unto this day.

#### **MATTHEW 27:9**

9 Then was fulfilled that which was spoken by Jeremy the prophet, saying, And they took the thirty pieces of silver, the price of him that was valued, whom they of the children of Israel did value;

### **BUT JEREMIAH DIDN'T SAY THAT**

#### **ZECHARIAH 11:12**

12 And I said unto them, If ye think good, give me my price; and if not, forbear. So they weighed for my price thirty pieces of silver.

### **ZECHARIAH 11:13**

13 And the LORD said unto me, Cast it unto the potter: a goodly price that I was prized at of them. And I took the thirty pieces of silver, and cast them to the potter in the house of the LORD.

### **WHAT COLOR WAS THE ROBE PLACED ON JESUS?**

#### **MATTHEW 27:28**

28 And they stripped him, and put on him a scarlet robe.

#### **JOHN 19:2**

2 And the soldiers platted a crown of thorns, and put it on his head, and they put on him a purple robe,

#### **MATTHEW 27:34**

#### **MATTHEW 12:40**

#### **MATTHEW 16:21**

21 ¶ From that time forth began Jesus to shew unto his disciples, how that he must go unto Jerusalem, and suffer many things of the elders and chief priests and scribes, and be killed, and be raised again the third day.

### **MATTHEW 17:23**

23 And they shall kill him, and the third day he shall be raised again. And they were exceeding sorry.

### **HOW DID JUDAS DIE?**

### **MATTHEW 27:5**

5 And he cast down the pieces of silver in the temple, and departed, and went and hanged himself.

### **ACTS 1:18**

18 Now this man purchased a field with the reward of iniquity; and falling headlong, he burst asunder in the midst, and all his bowels gushed out.

### **LUKE 24:3**

### **MATTHEW 28:2**

**ACTS 9:4**

4 And he fell to the earth, and heard a voice saying unto him, Saul, Saul, why persecutest thou me?

**ACTS 9:5**

5 And he said, Who art thou, Lord? And the Lord said, I am Jesus whom thou persecutest: it is hard for thee to kick against the pricks.

**ACTS 22:8**

8 And I answered, Who art thou, Lord? And he said unto me, I am Jesus of Nazareth, whom thou persecutest.

**ACTS 9:6**

6 And he trembling and astonished said, Lord, what wilt thou have me to do? And the Lord said unto him, Arise, and go into the city, and it shall be told thee what thou must do.
