No discussion of thoughts and their impact on your health would be complete without examining the words that arise out of your thoughts.

Words are the symbolic output of the exceptional processes happening on microanatomical, epigenetic and genetic level of the brain.

The words you speak are electromagnetic life forces that come from thoughts inside your brain. They are influenced by your five senses and result from choices you have made. They reflect your attitude.
