## **II CHRONICLES 26:16**

16 But when he was strong, his heart was lifted up to his destruction: for he transgressed against the LORD his God, and went into the temple of the LORD to burn incense upon the altar of incense.

17 And Azariah the priest went in after him, and with him fourscore priests of the LORD, that were valiant men:

And then the man, because that he feels in himself he'll do what he wants to, and won't submit to the Word, then he gets angry.
