

PURE RELIGION

JAMES 1:25

25 But whoso looketh into the perfect law of liberty, and continueth therein, he being not a forgetful hearer, but a doer of the work, this man shall be blessed in his deed.

JAMES 1:26

26 If any man among you seem to be religious, and bridleth not his tongue, but deceiveth his own heart, this man's religion is vain.

JAMES 1:27

27 *PURE religion and undefiled before God and the Father is this, To visit the fatherless and widows in their affliction, and to keep himself unspotted from the world.

PURE: katharos {kath-ar-os'}

Clean, ethically, free from corrupt desire, from sin and guilt; free from every admixture of what is false, sincere; genuine; blameless, innocent; unstained with the guilt of anything

RELIGION: threskeia {thrace-ki'-ah}

religious worship, esp. external, that which consists of ceremonies; religious discipline,

JAMES 1:27

27 Pure religion and undefiled before God and the Father is this, To *VISIT the fatherless and widows in their affliction, and to *KEEP himself unspotted from the world.

VISIT: episkeptomai {ep-ee-skep'-tom-ahee}

to look upon or after, to inspect, examine with the eyes, to look upon in order to help or to benefit,

KEEP: tereo {tay-reh'-o}

Reserve, watch, to attend to carefully, to guard, metaph. to keep, one in the state in which he is

JAMES 2:1

1 My brethren, have not the faith of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Lord of glory, with respect of persons.

JAMES 2:2

2 For if there come unto your assembly a man with a gold ring, in goodly apparel, and there come in also a poor man in vile raiment;

JAMES 2:3

3 And ye have respect to him that weareth the *GAY clothing, and say unto him, Sit thou here in a good place; and say to the poor, Stand thou there, or sit here under my footstool:

GAY: lampros {lam-pros'}
splendid, magnificent; splendid things i. e. luxuries or elegancies in dress or style

JAMES 2:4

4 Are ye not then partial in yourselves, and are become judges of evil thoughts?

JAMES 2:8

8 If ye fulfil the *ROYAL law according to the scripture, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself, ye do well:

ROYAL: basilikos {bas-il-ee-kos'}
king's country, of or belong to a king, kingly, regal;

JAMES 2:8

8 If ye fulfil the royal law according to the scripture, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself, ye do well:

MATTHEW 19:19

19 Honour thy father and thy mother: and, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself.

LUKE 10:25

25 And, behold, a certain lawyer stood up, and tempted him, saying, Master, what shall I do to inherit eternal life?

LUKE 10:26

26 He said unto him, What is written in the law? how readest thou?

LUKE 10:27

27 And he answering said, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy strength, and with all thy mind; and thy neighbour as thyself.

LUKE 10:28

28 And he said unto him, Thou hast answered right: this do, and thou shalt live.

LUKE 10:29

29 But he, willing to justify himself, said unto Jesus, And who is my neighbour?

LUKE 10:30

30 And Jesus answering said, A certain man went down from Jerusalem to Jericho, and fell among thieves, which stripped him of his raiment, and wounded him, and departed, leaving him half dead.

LUKE 10:31

31 And by chance there came down a certain priest that way: and when he saw him, he passed by on the other side.

LUKE 10:32

32 And likewise a Levite, when he was at the place, came and looked on him, and passed by on the other side.

LUKE 10:33

33 But a certain Samaritan, as he journeyed, came where he was: and when he saw him, he had compassion on him,

LUKE 10:34

34 And went to him, and bound up his wounds, pouring in oil and wine, and set him on his own beast, and brought him to an inn, and took care of him.

LUKE 10:35

35 And on the morrow when he departed, he took out two pence, and gave them to the host, and said unto him, Take care of him; and whatsoever thou spendest more, when I come again, I will repay thee.

LUKE 10:36

36 Which now of these three, thinkest thou, was neighbour unto him that fell among the thieves?

LUKE 10:37

37 And he said, He that shewed mercy on him. Then said Jesus unto him, Go, and do thou likewise.

MATTHEW 22:38

38 This is the first and great commandment.

MATTHEW 22:39

39 And the second is like unto it, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself.

GALATIANS 5:14

14 For all the law is fulfilled in one word, even in this; Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself.

JAMES 2:8
