MODEL PRAYER OF A GODLY MAN

MATTHEW 6:9

9 ¶ After this manner therefore pray ye: Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name.

MATTHEW 6:10

10 Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven.

MATTHEW 6:11

11 Give us this day our daily bread.

MATTHEW 6:12

12 And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors.

MATTHEW 6:13

13 And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil: For thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, for ever. Amen.

MATTHEW 6:9

9 ¶ After this manner therefore pray ye: Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name.

Elements in prayer (6:9-15): Jesus lists nine aspects of prayer.

- 1. **Faith**: "Our Father in heaven."
- 2. Worship: "May your name be honored."
- 3. **Expectation:** "May your kingdom come."

4. **Submission:** "May your will be done here on earth, just as it is in heaven."

- 5. **Petition:** "Give us our food for today."
- 6. **Confession:** "And forgive us our sins."

7. **Compassion:** "Just as we have forgiven those who have sinned against us."

8. **Dependence:** "And don't let us yield to temptation."

9. **Acknowledgment:** "For yours is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever. Amen."

MATTHEW 6:9

9 ¶ After this manner therefore pray ye: Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name.

FIRST PETITION:

Hallowed be thy name, that is, "Be held in reverence"; *regarded* and *treated* as holy.

The Greek word translated here as "hallowed" is the word from which we also get our English word "holy." It is translated in other places as "saint" or "sanctify." Usually it refers to setting something apart for God's use. Objects that were used in the temple were holy or sanctified because they were set apart for God's use in the temple worship. Christians are called holy for the same reason.

MATTHEW 6:10

10 Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven.

SECOND PETITION:

Thy kingdom come. The word kingdom here means reign.

THIRD PETITION

Thy will be done.

Thy will be done, as in heaven, so on earth. None can pray thus who have not merged their own wills into the divine will. It is mockery for disobedient lips to utter such a prayer.

MATTHEW 6:11

11 Give us this day our **daily** bread.

FOURTH PETITION

Give us this day, The word bread here denotes, everything necessary to sustain life. This petition implies our dependence on God for the supply of our needs.

MATTHEW 6:12

12 And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors.

FIFTH PETITION

And forgive us our debts, The word *debts* is here used figuratively. It does not mean *literally* that we are *debtors to God*, but that our sins have a resemblance to debts, or offences against God, offences which none but God can forgive.

The possession of God's forgiveness will make us forgiving.

MATTHEW 6:13

13 And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil: For thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, for ever. Amen.

SIXTH PETITION

Lead us not into temptation; keep us from being tempted, or if tempted, deliver us from the temptation, and from all evil.

Do not permit us to be overcome by evil but deliver us from the evil one.

God tempts no man, See <u>Jas 1:13</u>. This phrase, then, must be used in the **sense of** *permitting*. Do not *suffer* us, or *permit* us, to be tempted to sin. In this it is implied that God *has* such control over us and the tempter, as to save us from it if we call upon him.

MATTHEW 6:13

13 And lead us not into temptation, **but deliver us from evil**: For thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, forever. Amen.

but deliver us from evil: Pu σ ai $\eta\mu\alpha\varsigma$; a very expressive word break our chains, and loose our bands, snatch, pluck us from the evil, and its calamitous issue.

Deliver us from evil. The original, in this place, has deliver us from *THE evil*, that is, the evil one, or Satan.

MATTHEW 6:13

13 And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil: For thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, forever. Amen.

This doxology, or ascription of praise, is connected with the prayer by the word "*for*," to signify that all these things; the reign, power, and glory of God will be manifested by granting these petitions. It is so that God's name and perfections may be manifested.

For ever, to the for evers. Well expressed by our common translation ever in our ancient use of the word taking in the whole duration of time; the second ever, the whole of eternity.

Amen. This word is Hebrew, and signifies faithful or true. Some suppose the word is formed from the initial letters of **adoni**

melech neetnan, My Lord, the faithful King. The word itself implies a confident resting of the soul in God, with the fullest assurance that all these petitions shall be fulfilled to every one who prays according to the directions given before by our blessed Lord.

It means *verily, certainly, so be it*. This word was used by the people in the synagogue to signify their assent to the prayer that was uttered by the minister.

JAMES 5:14

14 Is any sick among you? let him call for the elders of the church; and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord:

JAMES 5:15

15 And the prayer of faith shall save the sick, and the Lord shall raise him up; and if he have committed sins, they shall be forgiven him.

<u>JAMES 5:16</u>

16 Confess your faults one to another, and pray one for another, that ye may be healed. The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man availeth much.

JAMES 5:17

17 Elias was a man subject to like passions as we are, and he prayed earnestly that it might not rain: and it rained not on the earth by the space of three years and six months.

JAMES 5:18

18 And he prayed again, and the heaven gave rain, and the earth brought forth her fruit.

JAMES 5:16

16 Confess your faults one to another, and pray one for another, that ye may be healed. The ***EFFECTUAL** fervent prayer of a righteous man availeth much.

EFFECTUAL: energeo {en-erg-eh'-o}

Put forth power, to work for one, to effect, to display one's activity, show one's self operative

The word signifies, "wrought by the energy of the Spirit." The word properly refers to that which has power; which in its own nature is fitted to produce an effect.

JAMES 5:16

16 Confess your faults one to another, and pray one for another, that ye may be healed. The effectual fervent prayer **of a righteous man** availeth much.

Then he went and prayed earnestly again; and the heavens give rain. Prayer changes things. I can't change it. You can't change it. It's prayer that changes it.

God told a man one time he was going to die, set his house in order, sent the prophet up to tell him. And the man turned his face to the wall, and begin to cry, and asked God for fifteen years longer to live. And God changed the course, give him fifteen years longer. What is it? Prayer.
