From all filthiness of the flesh. The noun here used (molusmou) occurs nowhere else in the New Testament. It means a soiling, hence defilement, pollution, and refers to the defiling and corrupting influence of fleshly desires and carnal appetites.

Perfecting. This word (epitelounte) means, properly, to bring to an end, to finish, complete. The idea here is, that of carrying it out to the completion.

I PETER 2:11

11 Dearly beloved, I beseech you as **strangers** and **pilgrims**, ***ABSTAIN** from ***FLESHLY** lusts, which war against the soul;

STRANGERS: a foreigner, one who lives in a place without the right of citizenship;

PILGRIMS: one who comes from a foreign country into a city or land to reside there by the side of the natives

ABSTAIN: apechomai {ap-ekh'-om-ahee} to hold one's self off, refrain, abstain

FLESHLY: sarkikos {sar-kee-kos'}

Carnal, having the nature of flesh, i.e. under the control of the animal appetites; governed by mere human nature not by the Spirit of God; pertaining to the flesh, i.e. to the body: related to birth, linage, etc

I THESSALONIANS 4:4

4 That every one of you should know how to possess his vessel in ***SANCTIFICATION** and ***HONOUR**;

SANCTIFICATION: {hag-ee-as-mos'}

Holiness, consecration, purification, sanctification of heart and life

HONOUR: time {tee-may'}

Price, precious, a valuing by which the price is fixed; honor which belongs or is shown to one: reverence

I THESSALONIANS 4:5

5 Not in the lust of ***CONCUPISCENCE**, even as the Gentiles which know not God:
