SONG OF SOLOMON 4:12

12 A garden inclosed is my sister, my spouse; a spring shut up, a fountain sealed.

SONG OF SOLOMON 4:13

13 Thy plants are an orchard of pomegranates, with pleasant fruits; camphire, with spikenard,

SONG OF SOLOMON 4:14

14 Spikenard and saffron; calamus and cinnamon, with all trees of frankincense; myrrh and aloes, with all the chief spices:

SONG OF SOLOMON 4:15

15 A fountain of gardens, a well of living waters, and streams from Lebanon.

SONG OF SOLOMON 4:16

16 Awake, O north wind; and come, thou south; blow upon my garden, that the spices thereof may flow out. Let my beloved come into his garden, and eat his pleasant fruits.

GENESIS 3:8

8 And they heard the voice of the LORD God walking in the garden in the *COOL of the day: and Adam and his wife hid themselves from the presence of the LORD God amongst the trees of the garden.

COOL: ruwach {roo'-akh} wind, breath, mind, spirit, spirit (as that which breathes quickly in animation)

EZEKIEL 37:4

4 Again he said unto me, Prophesy upon these bones, and say unto them, O ye dry bones, hear the word of the LORD.

EZEKIEL 37:7

7 So I prophesied as I was commanded: and as I prophesied, there was a noise, and behold a shaking, and the bones came together, bone to his bone.

EZEKIEL 37:8

8 And when I beheld, lo, the sinews and the flesh came up upon them, and the skin covered them above: but there was no breath in them.

EZEKIEL 37:9

JOHN 20:21

22 And when he had said this, he *BREATHED on them, and saith unto them, Receive ye the Holy Ghost:

BREATHED: emphusao {em-foo-sah'-o}

to blow or breathe upon; This word used only once by the in Gen 2:7 where God breathed on Adam and he became a living soul.

JOHN 3:8

8 The wind bloweth where it listeth, and thou hearest the sound thereof, but canst not tell whence it cometh, and whither it goeth: so is every one that is born of the Spirit.

JOHN 6:63

63 It is the spirit that quickeneth; the flesh profiteth nothing: the words that I speak unto you, they are spirit, and they are life.

SONG OF SOLOMON 4:16

GALATIANS 5:22

22 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith,

GALATIANS 5:23

23 Meekness, temperance: against such there is no law.

ROMANS 5:1

1 Therefore being justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ:

ROMANS 5:2

2 By whom also we have access by faith into this grace wherein we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God.

II CORINTHIANS 4:13

13 We having the same spirit of faith, according as it is written, I believed, and therefore have I spoken; we also believe, and therefore speak;

I THESSALONIANS 5:8

8 But let us, who are of the day, be sober, putting on the breastplate of faith and love; and for an helmet, the hope of salvation.

ROMANS 12:12

13 Distributing to the necessity of saints; given to hospitality.

PURE: katharos {kath-ar-os'}

Clean, purified by fire; free from corrupt desire, from sin and guilt; free from every admixture of what is false, sincere; genuine; blameless, innocent; unstained with the guilt of anything

I TIMOTHY 1:5

5 Now the end of the commandment is charity out of a pure heart, and of a good conscience, and of faith unfeigned:

II TIMOTHY 2:22

Flee also youthful lusts: but follow righteousness, faith, charity, peace, with them that call on the Lord out of a pure heart.

I PETER 1:22

22 Seeing ye have purified your souls in obeying the truth through the Spirit unto unfeigned love of the brethren, see that ye love one another with a pure heart fervently:

LUKE 21:19

19 In your patience possess ye your souls.

ROMANS 8:25

EPHESIANS 4:2

COLOSSIANS 3:12

12 Put on therefore, as the elect of God, holy and beloved, bowels of mercies, kindness, humbleness of mind, meekness, longsuffering;

II PETER 1:5

5 And beside this, giving all diligence, add to your faith virtue; and to virtue knowledge;

II PETER 1:6

of Christianity, the tranquil state of a soul assured of its salvation through Christ, and so fearing nothing from God and content with its earthly lot, of whatsoever sort that is

the blessed state of devout and upright men after death

ROMANS 8:6

6 For to be carnally minded is death; but to be spiritually minded is life and peace.

17 For the kingdom of God is not meat and drink; but righteousness, and peace, and joy in the Holy Ghost.

I TIMOTHY 2:3

3 For this is good and acceptable in the sight of God our Saviour;

I TIMOTHY 4:7

7 But refuse profane and old wives' fables, and exercise thyself rather unto godliness.

I TIMOTHY 4:8

8 For bodily exercise profiteth little: but godliness is profitable unto all things, having promise of the life that now is, and of that which is to come. I TIMOTHY 6:6

6 But godliness with contentment is great gain.

EPHESIANS 4:32

32 And be ye kind one to another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God for Christ's sake hath forgiven you.

COLOSSIANS 3:13

13 Forbearing one another, and forgiving one another, if any man have a quarrel against any: even as Christ forgave you, so also do ye.

LUKE 2:32

32 A light to *LIGHTEN the Gentiles, and the glory of thy people Israel.

LIGHTEN: apokalupsis {ap-ok-al'-oop-sis} Revelation, manifestation, a laying bear, a disclosure of truth, instruction, concerning things before unknown

ROMANS 16:25

Now to him that is of power to stablish you according to my gospel, and the preaching of Jesus Christ, according to the revelation of the mystery, which was kept secret since the world began,
