SONG OF SOLOMON 4:12

SONG OF SOLOMON 4:13

13 Thy plants are an orchard of pomegranates, with pleasant fruits; camphire, with spikenard,

SONG OF SOLOMON 4:14

14 Spikenard and saffron; calamus and cinnamon, with all trees of frankincense; myrrh and aloes, with all the chief spices:

SONG OF SOLOMON 4:15

15 A fountain of gardens, a well of living waters, and streams from Lebanon.

SONG OF SOLOMON 4:16

16 Awake, O north wind; and come, thou south; blow upon my garden, that the spices thereof may flow out. Let my beloved come into his garden, and eat his pleasant fruits.

ROMANS 12:12

12 Rejoicing in hope; *PATIENT in tribulation; continuing instant in prayer;

PATIENT: hupomeno {hoop-om-en'-o}

Endure, suffer, to preserve: under misfortunes and trials to hold fast to one's faith in Christ, bear bravely and calmly: ill treatments

COLOSSIANS 1:11

11 Strengthened with all might, according to his glorious power, unto all patience and longsuffering with joyfulness;

I THESSALONIANS 5:14

14 Now we exhort you, brethren, warn them that are unruly, comfort the feebleminded, support the weak, be patient toward all men.

HEBREWS 6:12

12 That ye be not slothful, but followers of them who through faith and patience inherit the promises.

GALATIANS 5:22

22 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith,

PEACE: eirene {i-ray'-nay}

Rest, quietness, exemption from the rage and havoc of war
harmony, security, safety, prosperity, felicity,

of Christianity, the tranquil state of a soul assured of its salvation through Christ, and so fearing nothing from God and content with its earthly lot, of whatsoever sort that is

the blessed state of devout and upright men after death

ROMANS 8:6

6 For to be carnally minded is death; but to be spiritually minded is life and peace.

ROMANS 14:17

17 For the kingdom of God is not meat and drink; but righteousness, and peace, and joy in the Holy Ghost.

ROMANS 15:13

13 Now the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, that ye may abound in hope, through the power of the Holy Ghost.

II CORINTHIANS 13:11

11 Finally, brethren, farewell. Be perfect, be of good comfort, be of one mind, live in *PEACE; and the God of love and peace shall be with you.

PEACE: eireneuo {i-rane-yoo'-o}

live peaceably, be at peace, to make peace, to cultivate or keep peace,

I TIMOTHY 2:2

2 For kings, and for all that are in authority; that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and honesty.

I TIMOTHY 2:3

3 For this is good and acceptable in the sight of God our Saviour;

I TIMOTHY 4:7

7 But refuse profane and old wives' fables, and exercise thyself rather unto godliness.

I TIMOTHY 4:8

8 For bodily exercise profiteth little: but godliness is profitable unto all things, having promise of the life that now is, and of that which is to come.

I TIMOTHY 6:6

6 But godliness with contentment is great gain.

TITUS 1:1

1 Paul, a servant of God, and an apostle of Jesus Christ, according to the faith of God's elect, and the acknowledging of the truth which is after godliness;

9 For what thanks can we render to God again for you, for all the joy wherewith we joy for your sakes before our God;

I THESSALONIANS 5:18

18 In every thing give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you.

COLOSSIANS 2:7

7 Rooted and built up in him, and stablished in the faith, as ye have been taught, *ABOUNDING therein with thanksgiving.

ABOUNDING: perisseuo {per-is-syoo'-o}

Exceed, to exceed a fixed number of measure; to be left over and above a certain number or measure, a thing which comes in abundance, to furnish one richly so that he has abundance

COLOSSIANS 4:2

2 Continue in prayer, and watch in the same with thanksgiving;

COLOSSIANS 3:15

15 And let the peace of God rule in your hearts, to the which also ye are called in one body; and be ye thankful.

II TIMOTHY 3:1

1 This know also, that in the last days perilous times shall come.

The word translated "perilous" means "violent, fierce, wild, difficult, grievous, hard to bear, distressing"

II TIMOTHY 3:2

2 For men shall be lovers of their own selves, covetous, boasters, proud, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, unthankful, unholy,

II TIMOTHY 3:2

MERCIFUL,

MATTHEW 5:7

7 Blessed are the merciful: for they shall obtain mercy.

LUKE 6:36

36 Be ye therefore merciful, as your Father also is merciful.

ROMANS 15:14

14 And I myself also am persuaded of you, my brethren, that ye also are full of goodness, filled with all knowledge, able also to admonish one another.

GALATIANS 5:22

EPHESIANS 5:9

9 (For the fruit of the Spirit is in all goodness and righteousness and truth;)

I CORINTHIANS 13:4

4 Charity suffereth long, and is kind; charity envieth not; charity vaunteth not itself, is not puffed up,

Origin of the word "kindness": The very word kindness comes from the cognate word, kinned, that is, one of the same kin or race;

acknowledging and reminding us of the fact that all men are brethren, all of the same blood and therefore they should all act as brethren. All who are of the same kindred should be kind.

COLOSSIANS 3:12

12 Put on therefore, as the elect of God, holy and beloved, bowels of mercies, kindness, humbleness of mind, meekness, longsuffering;

EPHESIANS 4:32

32 And be ye kind one to another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God for Christ's sake hath forgiven you.

GALATIANS 6:1

1 Brethren, if a man be overtaken in a fault, ye which are spiritual, restore such an one in the spirit of meekness; considering thyself, lest thou also be tempted.

EPHESIANS 4:2

2 With all lowliness and meekness, with longsuffering, forbearing one another in love;

COLOSSIANS 3:12

12 Put on therefore, as the elect of God, holy and beloved, bowels of mercies, kindness, humbleness of mind, meekness, longsuffering;

JAMES 1:21

21 Wherefore lay apart all filthiness and superfluity of naughtiness, and receive with meekness the engrafted word, which is able to save your souls.

GALATIANS 5:22

GALATIANS 5:23

23 Meekness, *TEMPERANCE: against such there is no law.

TEMPERANCE: egkrateia {eng-krat'-i-ah}

self control (the virtue of one who masters his desires and passions, especially his sensual appetites)

II PETER 1:6

6 And to knowledge temperance; and to temperance patience; and to patience godliness;

MATTHEW 6:14

14 For if ye forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you:

MATTHEW 6:15

15 But if ye forgive not men their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses.

MATTHEW 18:21

21 Then came Peter to him, and said, Lord, how oft shall my brother sin against me, and I forgive him? till seven times?

MATTHEW 18:22

22 Jesus saith unto him, I say not unto thee, Until seven times: but, Until seventy times seven.

LUKE 6:37

37 Judge not, and ye shall not be judged: condemn not, and ye shall not be condemned: forgive, and ye shall be forgiven:

II CORINTHIANS 2:6

6 Sufficient to such a man is this punishment, which was inflicted of many.

II CORINTHIANS 2:7

7 So that contrariwise ye ought rather to forgive him, and comfort him, lest perhaps such a one should be swallowed up with overmuch sorrow.

EPHESIANS 4:32

32 And be ye kind one to another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God for Christ's sake hath forgiven you.

Tenderhearted. Having a heart disposed to pity and compassion, and especially disposed to show kindness to the faults of erring brethren, for so the connexion demands.

COLOSSIANS 3:13

13 Forbearing one another, and forgiving one another, if any man have a quarrel against any: even as Christ forgave you, so also do ye.

DEUTERONOMY 29:29

29 The secret things belong unto the LORD our God: but those things which are revealed belong unto us and to our children forever, that we may do all the words of this law.

LUKE 2:30

30 For mine eyes have seen thy salvation,

LUKE 2:31

31 Which thou hast prepared before the face of all people;

LUKE 2:32

32 A light to *LIGHTEN the Gentiles, and the glory of thy people Israel.

LIGHTEN: apokalupsis {ap-ok-al'-oop-sis}

Revelation, manifestation, a laying bare, a disclosure of truth, instruction, concerning things before unknown

MATTHEW 11:27

27 All things are delivered unto me of my Father: and no man knoweth the Son, but the Father; neither knoweth any man the Father, save the Son, and he to whomsoever the Son will reveal him.

MATTHEW 16:17

17 And Jesus answered and said unto him, Blessed art thou, Simon Barjona: for flesh and blood hath not revealed it unto thee, but my Father which is in heaven.

LUKE 10:21

21 In that hour Jesus rejoiced in spirit, and said, I thank thee, O Father, Lord of heaven and earth, that thou hast hid these things from the wise and prudent, and hast revealed them unto babes: even so, Father; for so it seemed good in thy sight.
