THREE MONTHS AFTER THEY CAME OUT OF EGYPTIAN BONDAGE

EXODUS 20:1

1 ¶ And God spake all these words, saying,

EXODUS 20:2

2 I am the LORD thy God, which have brought thee out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of bondage.

EXODUS 20:3

3 Thou shalt have no other gods before me.

EXODUS 20:4

4 Thou shalt not make unto thee **any graven image**, or any likeness of any thing that is in heaven above, or that is in the earth beneath, or that is in the water under the earth:

EXODUS 31:16

16 Wherefore the children of Israel shall keep the sabbath, to observe the sabbath throughout their generations, for a perpetual covenant.

EXODUS 31:17

17 It is a sign between me and the children of Israel for ever: for in six days the LORD made heaven and earth, and on **the seventh day he rested, and was refreshed.**

EXODUS 31:18

18 And he gave unto Moses, when he had made an end of communing with him upon mount Sinai, two tables of testimony, tables of stone, written with the finger of God.

EXODUS 32:1

1 ¶ And when the people saw that **Moses delayed** to come down out of the mount, the people gathered themselves together unto Aaron, and said unto him, Up, **make us gods**, which shall go before us; for as for this Moses, the man that brought us up out of the land of Egypt, we wot not what is become of him.

EXODUS 32:2

2 And Aaron said unto them, Break off the golden earrings, which are in the ears of your wives, of your sons, and of your daughters, and bring them unto me.

EXODUS 32:3

3 And all the people brake off the golden earrings which were in their ears, and brought them unto Aaron.

EXODUS 32:4

4 And he received them at their hand, and fashioned it with a graving tool, after he had made it a molten calf: and they said, These be thy gods, O Israel, which brought thee up out of the land of Egypt.

EXODUS 32:5

5 And when Aaron saw it, he built an altar before it; and Aaron made proclamation, and said, To morrow is a feast to the LORD.

EXODUS 32:6

6 And they rose up early on the morrow, and offered burnt offerings, and brought peace offerings; and the people sat down to eat and to drink, and rose up to ***PLAY**.

to laugh, play, to jest, make sport, toy with, make a toy of

EXODUS 32:19

19 And it came to pass, as soon as he came nigh unto the camp, that he saw the calf, and the dancing: and Moses' anger

waxed hot, and he cast the tables out of his hands, and brake them beneath the mount.

EXODUS 32:25

25 And when Moses saw that the people were **naked**; (for Aaron had made them naked unto their shame among their enemies:)

EXODUS 32:7

7 ¶ And the LORD said unto Moses, Go, get thee down; for thy people, which thou broughtest out of the land of Egypt, have corrupted themselves:

EXODUS 32:8

8 They have turned aside quickly out of the way which I commanded them: they have made them a molten calf, and have worshipped it, and have sacrificed thereunto, and said, These be thy gods, O Israel, which have brought thee up out of the land of Egypt.

EXODUS 20:3

3 Thou shalt have no other gods before me.

EXODUS 20:4
