II CHRONICLES 28:17

17 For again the Edomites had come and smitten Judah, and carried away captives.

II CHRONICLES 28:18

18 The Philistines also had invaded the cities of the low country, and of the south of Judah, and had taken Bethshemesh, and Ajalon, and Gederoth, and Shocho with the villages thereof,

and Timnah with the villages thereof, Gimzo also and the villages thereof: and they dwelt there.

II CHRONICLES 28:19

19 For the LORD brought Judah low because of Ahaz king of Israel; for he made Judah naked, and transgressed sore against the LORD.

II CHRONICLES 28:20

II CHRONICLES 28:22

22 And in the time of his distress did he trespass yet more against the LORD: this is that king Ahaz.

II CHRONICLES 28:23

23 For he sacrificed unto the gods of Damascus, which smote him: and he said, Because the gods of the kings of Syria help them,

therefore will I sacrifice to them, that they may help me. But they were the ruin of him, and of all Israel.

II CHRONICLES 28:24

24 And Ahaz gathered together the vessels of the house of God, and cut in pieces the vessels of the house of God, and shut up the doors of the house of the LORD, and he made him altars in every corner of Jerusalem.

II CHRONICLES 28:25

25 And in every several city of Judah he made high places to burn incense unto other gods, and provoked to anger the LORD God of his fathers.

REVELATION 3:17

17 Because thou sayest, I am rich, and increased with goods, and have need of nothing; and knowest not that thou art wretched, and miserable, and poor, and blind, and naked:

REVELATION 3:18

18 I counsel thee to buy of me gold tried in the fire, that thou mayest be rich; and white raiment, that thou mayest be clothed, and that the shame of thy nakedness do not appear; and anoint thine eyes with eyesalve, that thou mayest see.

EXODUS 32:25

25 And when Moses saw that the people were naked; (for Aaron had made them naked unto their shame among their enemies:)

DEUTERONOMY 9:20

20 And the LORD was very angry with Aaron to have destroyed him: and I prayed for Aaron also the same time.

EXODUS 32:26

26 Then Moses stood in the gate of the camp, and said, Who is on the LORD'S side? let him come unto me. And all the sons of Levi gathered themselves together unto him.

EXODUS 32:27

27 And he said unto them, Thus saith the LORD God of Israel, Put every man his sword by his side, and go in and out from gate to gate throughout the camp,

and slay every man his brother, and every man his companion, and every man his neighbour.

EXODUS 32:28

28 And the children of Levi did according to the word of Moses: and there fell of the people that day about three thousand men.

EXODUS 32:29

29 For Moses had said, Consecrate yourselves to day to the LORD, even every man upon his son, and upon his brother; that he may bestow upon you a blessing this day.

EXODUS 32:30

30 And it came to pass on the morrow, that Moses said unto the people, Ye have sinned a great sin: and now I will go up unto the LORD; peradventure I shall make an atonement for your sin.
