CORRUPT: kapeleuo {kap-ale-yoo'-o} to be a retailer, to peddle, to make money by selling anything; to get sordid gain by dealing in anything, to do a thing for base gain;

It means literally to sell in small quantities, to retail for profit. But it was specially applied to tavern keeping, and extended to cover all the devices by which the wine-sellers in ancient times deceived their customers.

II CORINTHIANS 2:17

17 For we are not as many, which corrupt the word of God: but as of sincerity, but as of God, in the sight of God speak we in Christ.
