19 My little children, of whom I *TRAVAIL in birth again until Christ be formed in you,

TRAVAIL: odino {o-dee'-no} to feel the pains of child birth, to travail

GALATIANS 4:20

I desire to be present with you now, and to change my voice; for I stand in doubt of you.

PHILIPPIANS 3:17

Brethren, be followers together of me, and mark them which walk so as ye have us for an ensample.

PHILIPPIANS 3:18

18 (For many walk, of whom I have told you often, and now tell you even weeping, that they are the enemies of the cross of Christ:
