

THE LIVES OF THE PROPHETS MOSES 19

NUMBERS 20:1

1 Then came the children of Israel, even the whole congregation, into the desert of Zin in the first month: and the people abode in Kadesh; and Miriam died there, and was buried there.

NUMBERS 20:2

2 And there was no water for the congregation: and they gathered themselves together against Moses and against Aaron.

NUMBERS 20:3

3 And the people chode with Moses, and spake, saying, Would God that we had died when our brethren died before the LORD!

NUMBERS 20:4

4 And why have ye brought up the congregation of the LORD into this wilderness, that we and our cattle should die there?

NUMBERS 20:5

NUMBERS 20:7

7 And the LORD spake unto Moses, saying,

NUMBERS 20:8

8 Take the rod, and gather thou the assembly together, thou, and Aaron thy brother, and speak ye unto the rock before their eyes; and it shall give forth his water,

and thou shalt bring forth to them water out of the rock: so thou shalt give the congregation and their beasts drink.

NUMBERS 20:9

9 And Moses took the rod from before the LORD, as he commanded him.

NUMBERS 17:7

7 And Moses laid up the rods before the LORD in the tabernacle of witness.

NUMBERS 20:10

10 And Moses and Aaron gathered the congregation together before the rock, and he said unto them, Hear now, ye rebels; must we fetch you water out of this rock?

PSALM 106:32

32 They angered him also at the waters of strife, so that it went ill with Moses for their sakes:

PSALM 106:33

33 Because they provoked his spirit, so that he spake unadvisedly with his lips.

NUMBERS 12:3

3 (Now the man Moses was very meek, above all the men which were upon the face of the earth.)

ROMANS 4:11

11 And he received the sign of circumcision, a seal of the righteousness of the faith which he had yet being uncircumcised: that he might be the father of all them that believe,

though they be not circumcised; that righteousness might be imputed unto them also:

GALATIANS 3:7

7 Know ye therefore that they which are of faith, the same are the children of Abraham.

GALATIANS 3:9

9 So then they which be of faith are blessed with faithful Abraham.

GENESIS 12:12

12 Therefore it shall come to pass, when the Egyptians shall see thee, that they shall say, This is his wife: and they will kill me, but they will save thee alive.

GENESIS 12:13

13 Say, I pray thee, thou art my sister: that it may be well with me for thy sake; and my soul shall live because of thee.

I KINGS 19:1

1 And Ahab told Jezebel all that Elijah had done, and withal how he had slain all the prophets with the sword.

I KINGS 19:2

2 Then Jezebel sent a messenger unto Elijah, saying, So let the gods do to me, and more also, if I make not thy life as the life of one of them by to morrow about this time.

I KINGS 19:3

3 And when he saw that, he arose, and went for his life, and came to Beersheba, which belongeth to Judah, and left his servant there.

I KINGS 19:4

4 But he himself went a day's journey into the wilderness, and came and sat down under a juniper tree: and he requested for himself that he might die; and said, It is enough; now, O LORD, take away my life; for I am not better than my fathers.

I KINGS 19:10

10 And he said, I have been very jealous for the LORD God of hosts: for the children of Israel have forsaken thy covenant, thrown down thine altars,

and slain thy prophets with the sword; and I, even I only, am left; and they seek my life, to take it away.

LUKE 22:55

55 And when they had kindled a fire in the midst of the hall, and were set down together, Peter sat down among them.

LUKE 22:56

56 But a certain maid beheld him as he sat by the fire, and earnestly looked upon him, and said, This man was also with him.

LUKE 22:57

57 And he denied him, saying, Woman, I know him not.

LUKE 22:58

58 And after a little while another saw him, and said, Thou art also of them. And Peter said, Man, I am not.

LUKE 22:59

59 And about the space of one hour after another confidently affirmed, saying, Of a truth this fellow also was with him: for he is a Galilaean.

LUKE 22:60

60 And Peter said, Man, I know not what thou sayest. And immediately, while he yet spake, the cock crew.

NUMBERS 20:11

11 And Moses lifted up his hand, and with his rod he smote the rock twice: and the water came out abundantly, and the congregation drank, and their beasts also.

E-27 How many believes Moses was a prophet? He was, and God loved him. And when he went down there to the rock, God said, "You go down there and speak to the rock, and it'll bring forth its water. "

But Moses in his anger (he was high tempered), he went down there; instead of speaking to the rock, he smote the rock, and

smote it twice. That broke the whole picture of God's program. The rock was Christ; you believe that, don't you, ministers?

He was only smitten once, and we speak to Him now. Is that right? And Moses smote the Christ the second time. But that broke the whole picture of God's great program here, bursted it to pieces right there, Christ being smitten twice, when He's only smitten once.

But God was under obligation, He'd give that prophet the power to do so. But God dealt with Moses later about that. Is that right?

E-55 Instead of Moses doing what God told him to do, he went down and smote the rock again. Is that right?

Well, that absolutely broke the entire Scripture right in two,

right there. Christ wasn't smitten twice. He was smitten once. We just speak to Him from now on. Is that right? But when Moses smote the rock, that broke God's complete program and it was--he had done exactly what God told him not to do.

NUMBERS 20:12

12 And the LORD spake unto Moses and Aaron, Because ye believed me not, to sanctify me in the eyes of the children of Israel, therefore ye shall not bring this congregation into the land which I have given them.

NUMBERS 20:13

13 This is the water of Meribah; because the children of Israel strove with the LORD, and he was sanctified in them.

NUMBERS 20:22

22 And the children of Israel, even the whole congregation, journeyed from Kadesh, and came unto mount Hor.

NUMBERS 20:23

23 And the LORD spake unto Moses and Aaron in mount Hor, by the coast of the land of Edom, saying,

NUMBERS 20:24

24 Aaron shall be gathered unto his people: for he shall not enter into the land which I have given unto the children of Israel, because ye rebelled against my word at the water of Meribah.
