

THE LIVES OF THE PROPHETS MOSES 20

NUMBERS 20:7

7 And the LORD spake unto Moses, saying,

NUMBERS 20:8

8 Take the rod, and gather thou the assembly together, thou, and Aaron thy brother, and speak ye unto the rock before their eyes; and it shall give forth his water,

and thou shalt bring forth to them water out of the rock: so thou shalt give the congregation and their beasts drink.

NUMBERS 20:9

9 And Moses took the rod from before the LORD, as he commanded him.

NUMBERS 20:10

10 And Moses and Aaron gathered the congregation together before the rock, and he said unto them, Hear now, ye rebels; must we fetch you water out of this rock?

NUMBERS 20:11

11 And Moses lifted up his hand, and with his rod he smote the rock twice: and the water came out abundantly, and the congregation drank, and their beasts also.

NUMBERS 20:12

12 And the LORD spake unto Moses and Aaron, Because ye believed me not, to sanctify me in the eyes of the children of Israel, therefore ye shall not bring this congregation into the land which I have given them.

NUMBERS 20:13

13 This is the water of Meribah; because the children of Israel strove with the LORD, and he was sanctified in them.

NUMBERS 20:22

22 And the children of Israel, even the whole congregation, journeyed from Kadesh, and came unto mount Hor.

NUMBERS 20:23

23 And the LORD spake unto Moses and Aaron in mount Hor, by the coast of the land of Edom, saying,

NUMBERS 20:24

24 Aaron shall be gathered unto his people: for he shall not enter into the land which I have given unto the children of Israel, because ye rebelled against my word at the water of Meribah.

JOB 7:1

1 Is there not an appointed time to man upon earth? are not his days also like the days of an hireling?

JOB 14:5

5 Seeing his days are determined, the number of his months are with thee, thou hast appointed his bounds that he cannot pass;

JOB 14:14

14 If a man die, shall he live again? all the days of my appointed time will I wait, till my change come.

NUMBERS 20:24

24 Aaron shall be gathered unto his people: for he shall not enter into the land which I have given unto the children of Israel, because ye rebelled against my word at the water of Meribah.

NUMBERS 20:25

25 Take Aaron and Eleazar his son, and bring them up unto mount Hor:

NUMBERS 20:26

26 And strip Aaron of his garments, and put them upon Eleazar his son: and Aaron shall be gathered unto his people, and shall die there.

ISAIAH 61:1

1 The Spirit of the Lord GOD is upon me; because the LORD hath anointed me to preach good tidings unto the meek; he hath sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to them that are bound;

ISAIAH 61:2

2 To proclaim the acceptable year of the LORD, and the day of vengeance of our God; to comfort all that mourn;

ISAIAH 61:3

3 To appoint unto them that mourn in Zion, to give unto them beauty for ashes, the oil of joy for mourning, the garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness;

that they might be called trees of righteousness, the planting of the LORD, that he might be glorified.

EZEKIEL 16:8

8 Now when I passed by thee, and looked upon thee, behold, thy time was the time of love; and I spread my skirt over thee, and covered thy nakedness:

yea, I swore unto thee, and entered into a covenant with thee, saith the Lord GOD, and thou becamest mine.

EZEKIEL 16:9

9 Then washed I thee with water; yea, I thoroughly washed away thy blood from thee, and I anointed thee with oil.

EZEKIEL 16:10

10 I clothed thee also with brodered work, and shod thee with badgers' skin, and I girded thee about with fine linen, and I covered thee with silk.

EZEKIEL 16:11

11 I decked thee also with ornaments, and I put bracelets upon thy hands, and a chain on thy neck.

EZEKIEL 16:12

12 And I put a jewel on thy forehead, and earrings in thine ears, and a beautiful crown upon thine head.

EZEKIEL 16:13

13 Thus wast thou decked with gold and silver; and thy raiment was of fine linen, and silk, and brodered work; thou didst eat fine flour, and honey, and oil: and thou wast exceeding beautiful, and thou didst prosper into a kingdom.

LUKE 15:21

21 And the son said unto him, Father, I have sinned against heaven, and in thy sight, and am no more worthy to be called thy son.

LUKE 15:22

22 But the father said to his servants, Bring forth the best robe, and put it on him; and put a ring on his hand, and shoes on his feet:

REVELATION 19:8

8 And to her was granted that she should be arrayed in fine linen, clean and white: for the fine linen is the righteousness of saints.

NUMBERS 20:27

27 And Moses did as the LORD commanded: and they went up into mount Hor in the sight of all the congregation.

NUMBERS 20:28

28 And Moses stripped Aaron of his garments, and put them upon Eleazar his son; and Aaron died there in the top of the mount: and Moses and Eleazar came down from the mount.

NUMBERS 20:29

29 And when all the congregation saw that Aaron was dead, they mourned for Aaron thirty days, even all the house of Israel.

NUMBERS 21:4

4 And they journeyed from mount Hor by the way of the Red sea, to compass the land of Edom: and the soul of the people was much discouraged because of the way.

NUMBERS 21:5

5 And the people spake against God, and against Moses, Wherefore have ye brought us up out of Egypt to die in the wilderness? for there is no bread, neither is there any water; and our soul *LOATHETH this *LIGHT bread.

LOATHETH: {koots}

to be grieved, abhor, feel a loathing/abhorrence/sickening dread

LIGHT: qloqel {kel-o-kale'}

contemptible, worthless

NUMBERS 21:6

6 And the LORD sent fiery serpents among the people, and they bit the people; and much people of Israel died.

NUMBERS 21:7

7 Therefore the people came to Moses, and said, We have sinned, for we have spoken against the LORD, and against thee; pray unto the LORD, that he take away the serpents from us. And Moses prayed for the people.
