the new man, (neon) the Greek, means "the recently-put-on nature"; that lately received at regeneration.

The verb translated "renewed" is a present participle - "who is constantly being renewed. "

101 Hebrews 6 said, "If we sin willfully after received the knowledge of the Truth, there remaineth no more sacrifice for sin." Sin willfully. So if you continually want to sin, willfully, there is something wrong with your experience.
