I JOHN 3:9

"God's seed remains in him. "The word seed has a figurative connotation: "God's nature" or "God's principle of life. "God guards the new life he planted in the heart of the believer and causes it to develop.

The Christian, then, will not and cannot yield to sin because of that divine principle in his heart.

He that's born of God does not commit sin. He can't sin. Seed of God is in him. He can't sin. Has no more desire of sin, at all. So, long as you're desiring to sin, you're guilty of it.

But when you have no more desire, if you do anything wrong, then you don't willfully do it.

101 Hebrews 6 said, "If we sin willfully after received the knowledge of the Truth, there remaineth no more sacrifice for sin. " Sin willfully. So if you continually want to sin, willfully, there is something wrong with your experience.
