When the Roman Empire crucified a criminal or captive, the victim was often forced to carry his cross part of the way to the crucifixion site.

Carrying his cross through the heart of the city was supposed to be a tacit admission that the Roman Empire was correct in the sentence of death imposed on him, an admission that Rome was right and he was wrong.

So when Jesus enjoined His followers to carry their crosses and follow Him, He was referring to a public display before others that Jesus was right and that the disciples were following Him even to their deaths.

This is exactly what the religious leaders refused to do. Ausonius calls it, the extremity of torture. Cicero said, the most cruel and horrid suffering. When Ignatius was going to be exposed to the

fury of wild beasts for the name of Christ, he cries, "Now I begin to be a disciple. "
