

THE LIVES OF THE PROPHETS MOSES 33

DEUTERONOMY 31:21

21 And it shall come to pass, when many evils and troubles are befallen them, that this song shall testify against them as a witness;

for it shall not be forgotten out of the mouths of their seed: for I know their imagination which they go about, even now, before I have brought them into the land which I swear.

DEUTERONOMY 31:22

22 Moses therefore wrote this song the same day, and taught it the children of Israel.

DEUTERONOMY 31:23

23 And he gave Joshua the son of Nun a charge, and said, Be strong and of a good courage: for thou shalt bring the children of Israel into the land which I swear unto them: and I will be with thee.

DEUTERONOMY 31:24

24 And it came to pass, when Moses had made an end of writing the words of this law in a book, until they were finished,

DEUTERONOMY 31:25

25 That Moses commanded the Levites, which bare the ark of the covenant of the LORD, saying,

DEUTERONOMY 31:26

26 Take this book of the law, and put it in the side of the ark of the covenant of the LORD your God, that it may be there for a witness against thee.

DEUTERONOMY 31:27

27 For I know thy rebellion, and thy stiff neck: behold, while I am yet alive with you this day, ye have been rebellious against the LORD; and how much more after my death?

DEUTERONOMY 31:28

28 Gather unto me all the elders of your tribes, and your officers, that I may speak these words in their ears, and call heaven and earth to record against them.

DEUTERONOMY 31:29

29 For I know that after my death ye will utterly corrupt yourselves, and turn aside from the way which I have commanded you;

and evil will befall you in the latter days; because ye will do evil in the sight of the LORD, to provoke him to anger through the work of your hands.

DEUTERONOMY 31:30

30 And Moses spake in the ears of all the congregation of Israel the words of this song, until they were ended.

DEUTERONOMY 32:1

1 Give ear, O ye heavens, and I will speak; and hear, O earth, the words of my mouth.

DEUTERONOMY 32:2

2 My doctrine shall drop as the rain, my speech shall distil as the dew, as the small rain upon the tender herb, and as the showers upon the grass:

DEUTERONOMY 32:3

3 Because I will publish the name of the LORD: ascribe ye greatness unto our God.

DEUTERONOMY 32:4

4 He is the Rock, his work is perfect: for all his ways are judgment: a God of truth and without iniquity, just and right is he.

DEUTERONOMY 32:5

5 They have corrupted themselves, their spot is not the spot of his children: they are a perverse and crooked generation.

DEUTERONOMY 32:6

6 Do ye thus requite the LORD, O foolish people and unwise? is not he thy father that hath bought thee? hath he not made thee, and established thee?

DEUTERONOMY 32:7

7 Remember the days of old, consider the years of many generations: ask thy father, and he will shew thee; thy elders, and they will tell thee.

DEUTERONOMY 32:8

8 When the most High divided to the nations their inheritance, when he separated the sons of Adam, he set the bounds of the people according to the number of the children of Israel.

GENESIS 10:25

25 And unto Eber were born two sons: the name of one was Peleg; for in his days was the earth divided; and his brother's name was Joktan.

GENESIS 10:32

32 These are the families of the sons of Noah, after their generations, in their nations: and by these were the nations divided in the earth after the flood.

DEUTERONOMY 32:8

8 When the most High divided to the nations their inheritance, when he separated the sons of Adam, he set the bounds of the people according to the number of the children of Israel.

DEUTERONOMY 32:9

9 For the LORD'S portion is his people; Jacob is the lot of his inheritance.

ISAIAH 43:14

14 Thus saith the LORD, your redeemer, the Holy One of Israel; For your sake I have sent to Babylon, and have brought down all their nobles, and the Chaldeans, whose cry is in the ships.

ISAIAH 43:15

15 I am the LORD, your Holy One, the creator of Israel, your King.

ISAIAH 44:28

28 That saith of Cyrus, He is my shepherd, and shall perform all my pleasure: even saying to Jerusalem, Thou shalt be built; and to the temple, Thy foundation shall be laid.

This prophecy, concerning him, was nearly two hundred years before he was born. Josephus says, that Cyrus read this prophecy himself, which Isaiah had delivered out two hundred and ten years before hand.

ROMANS 8:28

28 And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to his purpose.

DEUTERONOMY 32:9

9 For the LORD'S portion is his people; Jacob is the lot of his inheritance.

PSALM 76:2

2 In Salem also is his tabernacle, and his dwelling place in Zion.

MATTHEW 16:18

18 And I say also unto thee, That thou art Peter, and upon this rock I will build my *CHURCH; and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it.

CHURCH: ekklesia {ek-klay-see'-ah}

18 The eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that ye may know what is the hope of his calling, and what the riches of the glory of his inheritance in the saints,
