*JESHURUN: Yshuruwn {yesh-oo-roon'}

"upright one", a symbolic name for Israel describing her ideal character.

4 Moses commanded us a law, even the inheritance of the congregation of Jacob.

5 And he was king in Jeshurun, when the heads of the people and the tribes of Israel were gathered together.

DEUTERONOMY 33:26

26 There is none like unto the God of Jeshurun, who rideth upon the heaven in thy help, and in his excellency on the sky.

ISAIAH 44:2

TAMMUZ: Tammuz {tam-mooz'}

"sprout of life", An idol personifying vegetable and animal life, worshipped in Phoenicia and Babylonia.
