Thistles multiply enormously; a species called the Carolina *sylvestris* bears ordinarily from 20 to 40 heads, each containing from 100 to 150 seeds.

Another species, called the *Acanthum vulgare*, produces over 100 heads, each containing from 300 to 400 seeds. If these thistles produce at a medium only 80 beads, and that each contains only 300 seeds; the first crop from these would amount to 24,000.

Let these be sown, and their crop will amount to 576 million. Sow these, and their produce will be 13,824,000,000,000, or thirteen billion, eight hundred and twenty-four thousand million;

and a single crop from these, which is only the third year's growth, would amount to 331,776,000,000,000,000, or three hundred and thirty-one thousand seven hundred and seventy-six billion;

and the fourth year's growth will amount to 7,962,624,000,000,000,000,000, or seven thousand nine hundred and sixty-two trillion, six hundred and twenty-four thousand billion.

A progeny more than sufficient to stock not only the surface of the whole world, but of all the planets of the solar system, so that

no other plant or vegetable could possibly grow, allowing but the space of one square foot for each plant.

The *Carduus vulgatissimus viarum*, or common hedge thistle, besides the almost infinite swarms of winged seeds it sends forth, spreads its roots around many yards,

and throws up suckers everywhere, which not only produce seeds in their turn, but extend their roots, propagate like the parent plant, and stifle and destroy all vegetation but their own.
