

## **FAITH IS THE VICTORY**

### **JOHN 16:33**

33 These things I have spoken unto you, that in me ye might have peace. In the world ye shall have tribulation: but be of good cheer; I have overcome the world.

### **I JOHN 5:4**

4 For whatsoever is born of God overcometh the world: and this is the victory that overcometh the world, even our faith.

### **I JOHN 5:5**

5 Who is he that overcometh the world, but he that believeth that Jesus is the Son of God?

### **JOHN 16:33**

33 These things I have spoken unto you, that in me ye might have peace. In the world ye shall have tribulation: but be of good cheer; I have overcome the world.

### **I JOHN 5:4**

4 For whatsoever is born of God overcometh the world: and this is the victory that overcometh the world, even our faith.

**Whatsoever is born of God is in the Greek lit. "the thing that is begotten out of God,"**

**"Born"** is perfect in tense, **referring to a past completed act of regeneration with the present result** that that regenerated individual has been made a partaker of the divine nature and as such is a child of God.

### **I JOHN 5:4**

4 For whatsoever is born of God overcometh the world: and this is the victory that overcometh the world, even our faith.

**The phrase, the victory that overcomes renders a Greek construction of a verbal noun, "the conquest that conquers," or "the overcoming/defeating that overcomes/defeats."**

### **I JOHN 5:5**

5 Who is he that overcometh the world, but he that believeth that Jesus is the Son of God?

The verb is in the present tense, "**is constantly overcoming the world.**" It is a habit of life with the saint to gain victory over the world.

### **HEBREWS 11:3**

3 **Through faith** we understand that the worlds were framed by the word of God, so that things which are seen were not made of things which do appear.

### **HEBREWS 11:4**

4 ¶ **By faith Abel** offered unto God a more excellent sacrifice than Cain, by which he obtained witness that he was righteous, God testifying of his gifts: and by it he being dead yet speaketh.

### **HEBREWS 11:5**

5 **By faith Enoch** was translated that he should not see death; and was not found, because God had translated him: for before his translation he had this testimony, that he pleased God.

### **HEBREWS 11:7**

7 **By faith Noah**, being warned of God of things not seen as yet, moved with fear, prepared an ark to the saving of his house; by the which he condemned the world, and became heir of the righteousness which is by faith.

### **HEBREWS 11:8**

8 **By faith Abraham**, when he was called to go out into a place which he should after receive for an inheritance, obeyed; and he went out, not knowing whither he went.

### **HEBREWS 11:11**

11 **Through faith also Sara** herself received strength to conceive seed, and was delivered of a child when she was past age, because she judged him faithful who had promised.

### **HEBREWS 11:20**

20 **By faith Isaac** blessed Jacob and Esau concerning things to come.

### **HEBREWS 11:23**

23 **By faith Moses**, when he was born, was hid three months of his parents, because they saw he was a proper child; and they were not afraid of the king's commandment.

### **HEBREWS 11:24**

24 **By faith Moses**, when he was come to years, refused to be called the son of Pharaoh's daughter;

### **HEBREWS 11:29**

29 **By faith they** passed through the Red sea as by dry land: which the Egyptians assaying to do were drowned.

### **HEBREWS 11:30**

30 **By faith** the walls of Jericho fell down, after they were compassed about seven days.

### **HEBREWS 11:31**

31 **By faith the harlot Rahab** perished not with them that believed not, when she had received the spies with peace.

### **HEBREWS 11:32**

32 ¶ And what shall I more say? for the time would fail me to tell of Gedeon, and of Barak, and of Samson, and of Jephthae; of David also, and Samuel, and of the prophets:

### **HEBREWS 11:33**

33 Who **through faith** subdued kingdoms, wrought righteousness, obtained promises, stopped the mouths of lions,

### **HEBREWS 11:34**

34 Quenched the violence of fire, escaped the edge of the sword, out of weakness were made strong, waxed valiant in fight, turned to flight the armies of the aliens.
