And for this cause he is the mediator of the new testament, that by means of death, for the redemption of the transgressions that were under the first testament, **they which** are called might receive the promise of eternal inheritance.

The word "mediator" is the translation of <u>(mesites)</u> which refers to one who intervenes between two, either to make or restore peace and friendship, to form a compact, or to ratify a covenant.

All things required in a testament are found here, namely, a testator deceased, Christ Jesus: Legacies bequeathed, temporal, spiritual, and eternal blessings; legates (LEG-A-TEE) named, the heirs of promise; conditions required, upon which only the legacies may be obtained, faith, repentance, and sincere obedience; seals annexed, baptism, and the Lord's supper; witnesses subscribing, the Father, the Word, and the Holy Ghost.

HEBREWS 9:15

And for this cause he is the mediator of the new testament, that by means of death, for the redemption of the transgressions that were under the first testament, they which are called might receive the promise of eternal inheritance.

HEBREWS 9:16

16 For where a testament is, there must also of necessity be the death of the testator.

HEBREWS 7:25

25 Wherefore he is able also to save them to the uttermost that come unto God by him, seeing he ever liveth to make intercession for them.
