The Greek word for "sure" (bebaian) was used in classical Greek to refer to a warranty deed somewhat like those people use today on houses and other pieces of property.

Bebaian is rendered "secure" (Heb 6:19), "guaranteed" (Rom 4:16), "firm" (2 Cor 1:7), "courage" (Heb 3:6), "confidence" (Heb 3:14), and "in force" (Heb 9:17).

This word "stumble" does not suggest that a believer loses his salvation, for salvation does not depend on one's spiritual growth. The Greek word for stumble means "to trip up" or "to experience a reversal."
