### **MARK 3:14**

14 And he ordained twelve, that they should be with him, and that he might send them forth **to preach**,

### **MARK 16:15**

15 And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and **preach the gospel** to every creature.

### **LUKE 9:1**

1 ¶ Then he called his twelve disciples together, and gave them power and authority over all devils, and to cure diseases.

### **LUKE 9:2**

2 And he sent them to **preach** the kingdom of God, and to heal the sick.

### **ACTS 5:42**

42 And daily in the temple, and in every house, they ceased not to **teach and preach Jesus Christ**.

### **I CORINTHIANS 1:23**

23 **But we preach Christ** crucified, unto the Jews a stumblingblock, and unto the Greeks foolishness;

### **I CORINTHIANS 9:14**

14 Even so hath the Lord ordained that they which **preach the gospel** should live of the gospel.

### **I CORINTHIANS 9:16**

16 For though I preach the gospel, I have nothing to glory of: for necessity is laid upon me; yea, **woe is unto me, if I preach not the gospel!**

### **II TIMOTHY 4:2**

2 **Preach the word**; be instant in season, out of season; reprove, rebuke, exhort with all longsuffering and doctrine.

### **ROMANS 10:15**

15 And how shall they preach, except **they be sent**? as it is written, How beautiful are the feet of them that preach the gospel of peace, and bring glad tidings of good things!

### **LUKE 4:18**

18 The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he hath anointed me to preach the gospel to the poor; **he hath sent me** to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captives, and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty them that are bruised,

### **LUKE 4:43**

43 And he said unto them, I must preach the kingdom of God to other cities also: **for therefore am I sent.**

### **LUKE 9:2**

2 And **he sent them** to preach the kingdom of God, and to heal the sick.

### **I CORINTHIANS 1:17**

17 ¶ For Christ sent me not to baptize, **but to preach** the gospel: not with wisdom of words, lest the cross of Christ should be made of none effect.

### **JOHN 3:2**

2 The same came to Jesus by night, and said unto him, Rabbi, we know that thou art a teacher come from God: for no man can do these miracles that thou doest, except God be with him.

### **JOHN 3:3**

3 Jesus answered and said unto him, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be **\*BORN** **\*AGAIN**, he cannot see the kingdom of God.

### **JOHN 3:4**

4 Nicodemus saith unto him, How can a man be born when he is old? can he enter the second time into his mother's womb, and be born?

### **JOHN 3:5**

5 Jesus answered, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be **born of water** and **of the Spirit**, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God.

### **JOHN 3:6**

6 That which is born of the flesh is flesh; and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit.

### **JOHN 3:7**

7 Marvel not that I said unto thee, **Ye must be born again.**

### **JOHN 3:8**

8 The wind bloweth where it listeth, and thou hearest the sound thereof, but canst not tell whence it cometh, and whither it goeth: **so is every one that is born of the Spirit.**

### **JOHN 3:9**

9 Nicodemus answered and said unto him, How can these things be?

### **JEREMIAH 31:33**

33 But this shall be the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel; After those days, saith the LORD, I will put my law in their inward parts, and write it in their hearts; and will be their God, and they shall be my people.

**GALATIANS 6:15**

15 For in Christ Jesus neither circumcision availeth any thing, nor uncircumcision, **but a new creature.**

**JOHN 1:11**

11 He came unto his own, and his own received him not.

**JOHN 1:12**

12 But as many as received him, to them **gave he power** to **\*BECOME** the sons of God, even to them that believe on his name:

15 ¶ If ye love me, keep my commandments.

**JOHN 14:16**

16 And I will pray the Father, and he shall give you another **Comforter**, that he may abide with you for ever;

**JOHN 14:17**

17 Even the **Spirit of truth**; whom the world cannot receive, because it seeth him not, neither knoweth him: but ye know him; **for he dwelleth with you, and shall be in you.**

### **JOHN 14:18**

18 ¶ I will not leave you comfortless: I will come to you.

### **JOHN 14:20**

20 At that day ye shall know that I am in my Father, and ye in me, and **I in you**.

### **JOHN 14:26**

26 But the Comforter, which is the Holy Ghost, whom the Father will send in my name, he shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you.

### **ACTS 1:1**

1 ¶ The former treatise have I made, O Theophilus, of all that Jesus began both to do and teach,

### **ACTS 1:2**

2 Until the day in which he was taken up, after that he through the Holy Ghost had given commandments unto the apostles whom he had chosen:

### **ACTS 1:3**

3 To whom also he shewed himself alive after his passion by many infallible proofs, being seen of them forty days, and speaking of the things pertaining to the kingdom of God:

### **ACTS 1:4**

4 And, being assembled together with them, commanded them that they should not depart from Jerusalem, but wait for the promise of the Father, which, saith he, ye have heard of me.

### **ACTS 1:5**

5 For John truly baptized with water; but ye shall be **\*BAPTIZED** with the Holy Ghost not many days hence.

**BAPTIZED:** GREEK LEXICON -- STRONG'S NUMBER 907

to dip repeatedly, to immerse, to submerge (of vessels sunk)

**ACTS 1:8**

8 But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth.

**ACTS 2:4**

4 And they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance.

**ACTS 2:38**

38 Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost.

**ACTS 2:39**

39 For the promise is unto you, and to your children, and to all that are afar off, even as many as the Lord our God shall call.

**ACTS 5:31**

31 Him hath God exalted with his right hand to be a Prince and a Saviour, for to give repentance to Israel, and forgiveness of sins.

**ACTS 5:32**

32 And we are his witnesses of these things; and **so is also the Holy Ghost, whom God hath given to them that obey him.**

**ACTS 8:14**

14 ¶ Now when the apostles which were at Jerusalem heard that Samaria had **received the word of God**, they sent unto them Peter and John:

**ACTS 8:15**

15 Who, when they were come down, prayed for them, **that they might receive the Holy Ghost:**

**ACTS 8:16**

16 (For as yet he was fallen upon none of them: **only they were baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus.**)

**ACTS 8:17**

17 Then laid they their hands on them, and **they received the Holy Ghost.**

**ACTS 9:17**

17 And Ananias went his way, and entered into the house; and putting his hands on him said, Brother Saul, the Lord, even Jesus, that appeared unto thee in the way as thou camest, hath sent me, that thou mightest receive thy sight, **and be filled with the Holy Ghost.**

**ACTS 10:22**

22 And they said, Cornelius the centurion, **a just man**, and one that feareth God, and of good report among all the nation of the Jews, **was warned from God by an holy angel** to send for thee into his house, and to hear words of thee.

**ACTS 10:44**

44 ¶ While Peter yet spake these words, **the Holy Ghost fell on all them which heard the word.**

**ACTS 10:45**

45 And they of the circumcision which believed were astonished, as many as came with Peter, because that **on the Gentiles also was poured out the gift of the Holy Ghost.**

**ACTS 10:46**

46 For they heard them speak with tongues, and magnify God. Then answered Peter,

**ACTS 10:47**

47 Can any man forbid water, that these should not be baptized, **which have received the Holy Ghost as well as we?**

### **ACTS 11:13**

13 And he shewed us how he had seen an angel in his house, which stood and said unto him, Send men to Joppa, and call for Simon, whose surname is Peter;

### **ACTS 11:14**

14 Who shall tell thee words, whereby thou and all thy house shall be saved.

### **ACTS 11:15**

15 And as I began to speak, the Holy Ghost fell on them, as on us at the beginning.

### **ACTS 11:16**

16 Then remembered I the word of the Lord, how that he said, John indeed baptized with water; **but ye shall be baptized with the Holy Ghost.**

### **ACTS 11:17**

17 Forasmuch then as God gave them the like gift as he did unto us, who believed on the Lord Jesus Christ; what was I, that I could withstand God?

### **ACTS 11:18**

18 When they heard these things, they held their peace, and glorified God, saying, Then hath God also to the Gentiles granted repentance unto life.

### **ACTS 19:1**

1 ¶ And it came to pass, that, while Apollos was at Corinth, Paul having passed through the upper coasts came to Ephesus: and **finding certain disciples,**

### **ACTS 19:2**

2 He said unto them, **Have ye received the Holy Ghost since ye \*BELIEVED?** And they said unto him, We have not so much as heard whether there be any Holy Ghost.

**BELIEVED:** GREEK LEXICON -- STRONG'S NUMBER 4100

### **ACTS 19:3**

3 And he said unto them, Unto what then were ye baptized? And they said, Unto John's baptism.

### **ACTS 19:4**

4 Then said Paul, John verily baptized with the baptism of repentance, saying unto the people, that they should believe on him which should come after him, that is, on Christ Jesus.

### **ACTS 19:5**

5 When they heard this, **they were baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus.**

### **ACTS 19:6**

6 And when Paul had laid his hands upon them, **the Holy Ghost came on them;** and they spake with tongues, and prophesied.

### **ACTS 19:7**

7 And all the men were about twelve.

### **ROMANS 15:13**

13 ¶ Now the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, that ye may abound in hope, **through the power of the Holy Ghost.**

### **I CORINTHIANS 12:3**

3 Wherefore I give you to understand, that no man speaking by the Spirit of God calleth Jesus accursed: and that **no man can say that Jesus is the Lord, but by the Holy Ghost.**

### **I CORINTHIANS 12:13**

13 For by one Spirit are we all **baptized** into one body, whether we be Jews or Gentiles, whether we be bond or free; and have been **all made to drink into one Spirit.**

### **EPHESIANS 1:13**

13 In whom ye also trusted, after that ye heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation: in whom also **after that ye believed**, ye were **\*SEALED** with that holy Spirit of promise,

### **EPHESIANS 4:30**

30 And grieve not the holy Spirit of God, whereby ye are **sealed unto the day of redemption.**

### **I JOHN 2:29**

29 If ye know that he is righteous, ye know that every one that **\*DOETH righteousness is born of him.**

### **ROMANS 6:1**

1 ¶ What shall we say then? Shall we continue in sin, that grace may abound?

### **ROMANS 6:2**

2 God forbid. How shall we, that are dead to sin, **live any longer therein?**

### **ROMANS 6:3**

3 Know ye not, that so many of us as were **baptized into Jesus Christ** were baptized into his death?

### **ROMANS 6:4**

4 Therefore we are buried with him by baptism into death: that like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, **even so we also should walk in newness of life.**

### **ROMANS 6:5**

5 For if we have been planted together in the likeness of his death, we shall be also in the likeness of his resurrection:

### **ROMANS 6:6**

6 Knowing this, that **our old man is crucified with him**, that the body of sin might be destroyed, that henceforth we should not serve sin.

### **ROMANS 6:7**

7 For he that is dead is freed from sin.

### **ROMANS 6:8**

8 Now if we be dead with Christ, we believe that we shall also live with him:

### **ROMANS 6:9**

9 Knowing that Christ being raised from the dead dieth no more; death hath no more dominion over him.

### **ROMANS 6:10**

10 For in that he died, he died unto sin once: but in that he liveth, he liveth unto God.

### **ROMANS 6:11**

11 Likewise reckon ye also yourselves **to be dead indeed unto sin**, but alive unto God through Jesus Christ our Lord.

### **ROMANS 6:12**

12 Let not sin therefore reign in your mortal body, that ye should obey it in the lusts thereof.

### **ROMANS 6:13**

13 Neither yield ye your members as instruments of unrighteousness unto sin: but yield yourselves unto God, **as those that are alive from the dead**, and your members as instruments of righteousness unto God.

### **ROMANS 6:14**

14 **For sin shall not have dominion over you:** for ye are not under the law, but under grace.

### **ROMANS 6:15**

15 What then? shall we sin, because we are not under the law, but under grace? God forbid.

### **ROMANS 6:16**

16 Know ye not, that to whom ye yield yourselves servants to obey, his servants ye are to whom ye obey; whether of sin unto death, or of obedience unto righteousness?

### **ROMANS 6:17**

17 But God be thanked, that ye were the servants of sin, but ye have obeyed from the heart that form of doctrine which was delivered you.

### **ROMANS 6:18**

18 **Being then made free from sin**, ye became the servants of righteousness.

**ROMANS 6:19**

19 I speak after the manner of men because of the infirmity of your flesh: for as ye have yielded your members servants to uncleanness and to iniquity unto iniquity; even so now yield your members servants to righteousness unto holiness.

**ROMANS 6:20**

20 For when ye were the servants of sin, ye were free from righteousness.

**ROMANS 6:21**

21 What fruit had ye then in those things whereof ye are now ashamed? for the end of those things is death.

**ROMANS 6:22**

22 But now being made free from sin, and become servants to God, ye have your fruit unto holiness, and the end everlasting life.

**ROMANS 6:23**

23 For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.

**I CORINTHIANS 9:27**

27 But I **\*KEEP** under my body, and bring it into subjection: lest that by any means, when I have preached to others, I myself should be a castaway.

**KEEP:** GREEK LEXICON -- STRONG'S NUMBER 5299

10 For we are his workmanship, **created in Christ Jesus unto good works**, which God hath before ordained that we should walk in them.

## **EPHESIANS 4:21**

21 If so be that ye have heard him, and have been taught by him, as the truth is in Jesus:

## **EPHESIANS 4:22**

22 That ye **put off** concerning the former conversation **the old man**, which is corrupt according to the deceitful lusts;

## **EPHESIANS 4:23**

23 And be renewed in the spirit of your mind;

## **EPHESIANS 4:24**

24 And that ye put on the **new man**, which **after God is created in righteousness and true holiness**.

## **EPHESIANS 4:25**

25 Wherefore putting away lying, speak every man truth with his neighbour: for we are members one of another.

## **EPHESIANS 4:26**

26 Be ye angry, and sin not: let not the sun go down upon your wrath:

**EPHESIANS 4:27**

27 Neither give place to the devil.

28 Let him that stole steal no more: but rather let him labour, working with his hands the thing which is good, that he may have to give to him that needeth.
