Orion consists of seven major stars: two for his shoulders, two for his feet, and three for his belt. Each star has a name.

Astronomers measure distance in light-years. One light-year is the distance light travels in one year: 5. 88 trillion miles. To go one light-year in the Space Shuttle would take you about 40,000 years!

THE BRIGHTEST IS RIGEL (RYE-JEL) AT AROUND 800 LIGHT YEARS.

Rigel is 66,000 times more powerful than the sun. Rigel, a blue supergiant star, is 18 times more massive than the sun and 74 times its size.

The light you see from Rigel some spring or winter night, started on its journey a least 250 years before Columbus stumbled upon the outskirts of the already populated North America in his failed attempt to sail to the Orient.

Betelgeuse is also the largest star in the constellation, it has 1,000 times the radius of the sun.

The three stars which form a line through the middle of the constellation are known as Orion's Belt.

If you follow an imaginary line down through Orion's Belt it will take you to the brightest star in the night sky, Sirius, follow the line up in the southern hemisphere.

The constellations have been known from antiquity and they have been basically unchanged.

Taurus and Ursa Major, for example, appear in cave art.

The names of the stars have retained their meaning in various languages.

For instance, the constellation "Virgo," meaning "virgin" is referred to as "Bethulah" in Hebrew, "Parthenos" in Greek, "Kanya" in Hindi – all of which mean "virgin."

VIRGO – The virgin holding a branch and an ear of corn; the promised seed of the woman.

LIBRA – The scales; the price deficient balanced by the price that covers.

SCORPIO – The scorpion; the attack of the enemy; the redeemer's conflict.

SAGITTARIUS – The archer; the gracious one; the redeemer's triumph.

CAPRICORNUS – The sea goat; the goat of atonement slain for the redeemed.

AQUARIUS – The water bearer; the living waters of blessing poured forth for the redeemed.

PISCES – The fishes; the multitudes who will follow; the blessings of the redeemed.

ARIES – The ram or lamb; wounded and slain, the blessings of the redeemed consummated.

TAURUS – The bull; the congregation of the judge; the coming judge of all the earth.

GEMINI – The twins; two natures; the reign of the prince of peace.

CANCER – The crab; assembled together; the redeemer's possessions held fast.

LEO – The Lion of the tribe of Judah; the consummated triumph of the redeemer in the end.

The name "Arcturus," comes from the ancient Greek Arktouros, which means Bear Guard or The Watcher of the Bear.

The name refers to Arcturus' proximity to Ursa Major and Ursa Minor ("The Great Bear" and "The Lesser Bear.")
