EYE: HEBREW LEXICON -- STRONG'S NUMBER 5869 'ayin {ah'-yin} of physical eye, as showing mental qualities, of mental and spiritual faculties (figurative)

MATTHEW 13:15

15 For this people's heart is waxed gross, and their ears are dull of hearing, and their eyes they have closed; lest at any time they should see with their eyes, and hear with their ears, and should understand with their heart, and should be converted, and I should heal them.

MATTHEW 13:16

REPENT: HEBREW LEXICON -- STRONG'S NUMBER 5162 nacham {naw-kham'} to be sorry, console oneself, regret, suffer grief,

II CORINTHIANS 7:10

10 For godly sorrow worketh repentance to salvation not to be repented of: but the sorrow of the world worketh death.

JOB 42:7

7 ¶ And it was so, that after the LORD had spoken these words unto Job, the LORD said to Eliphaz the Temanite, My wrath

is kindled against thee, and against thy two friends: for ye have not spoken of me the thing that is right, as my servant Job hath.

SONG OF SOLOMON 6:3
