

THE CHURCH 32

EPHESIANS 5:23

23 For the husband is the head of the wife, even as Christ is the head of **the church**: and he is the saviour of the body.

EPHESIANS 5:24

24 Therefore as **the church** is subject unto Christ, so let the wives be to their own husbands in everything.

EPHESIANS 5:25

25 Husbands, love your wives, even as Christ also loved **the church**, and gave himself for it;

EXODUS 3:7

EXODUS 3:10

LEVITICUS 26:11

11 And I will set my tabernacle among you: and my soul shall not abhor you.

14 If **my people**, which are called by my name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek my face, and turn from

HOSEA 2:23

23 And I will sow her unto me in the earth; and I will have mercy upon her that had not obtained mercy; and I will say to them which were not my people, **Thou art my people; and they shall say, Thou art my God.**

II CORINTHIANS 6:16

16 And what agreement hath the temple of God with idols? for ye are the temple of the living God; as God hath said, I will dwell in them, and walk in them; and I will be their God, and they shall be **my people**.

REVELATION 18:4

4 And I heard another voice from heaven, saying, Come out of her, **my people**, that ye be not partakers of her sins, and that ye receive not of her plagues.

II CORINTHIANS 6:17

17 Wherefore come out from among them, and be ye ***SEPARATE**, saith the Lord, and touch not the unclean thing; and I will receive you,

SEPARATE: aphorizo {af-or-id'-zo}

to mark off from others by boundaries, to limit, to separate, to exclude as disreputable, to appoint, set apart for some purpose

II CORINTHIANS 6:18

18 And will be a Father unto you, and ye shall be my sons and daughters, saith the Lord Almighty.

Have you ever noticed how the world gets into the spirit of things that are in the world? Our spirit is clean. It is fresh. It is real. It is sober and serious but nonetheless, **full of the joy of the Lord.** The Christian ought to be just as exuberant and full of his pleasure in the Lord as the world is when it savors and delights in its pleasures. Both Christians and the world are human; both have emotions. The difference is the Christians' hearts and emotions are purely on the Lord of Glory and His love, **while the world satisfies the flesh.**

EXODUS 34:9

9 And he said, If now I have found grace in thy sight, O Lord, let my Lord, I pray thee, go among us; for it is a stiffnecked people; and pardon our iniquity and our sin, and **take us for thine inheritance.**

DEUTERONOMY 4:20

20 But the LORD hath taken you, and brought you forth out of the iron furnace, even out of Egypt, to be unto him **a people of inheritance,** as ye are this day.

DEUTERONOMY 9:26

26 I prayed therefore unto the LORD, and said, O Lord GOD, destroy not thy people and **thine inheritance**, which thou hast redeemed through thy greatness, which thou hast brought forth out of Egypt with a mighty hand.

DEUTERONOMY 9:29

29 Yet they are thy people and **thine inheritance**, which thou broughtest out by thy mighty power and by thy stretched out arm.

DEUTERONOMY 32:9

9 For **the LORD'S portion is his people**; Jacob is the lot of **his inheritance**.

EPHESIANS 1:18

18 The eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that ye may know what is the hope of his calling, and what the riches of the glory of **his inheritance in the saints**,

DEUTERONOMY 7:6

6 For thou art an holy people unto the LORD thy God: the LORD thy God hath chosen thee to be **a special people unto himself**, above all people that are upon the face of the earth.

EXODUS 19:5

5 Now therefore, if ye will obey my voice indeed, and keep my covenant, then ye shall be a **peculiar** treasure unto me above all people: for all the earth is mine:

DEUTERONOMY 14:2

2 For thou art an holy people unto the LORD thy God, and the LORD hath chosen thee to be a **peculiar** people unto himself, above all the nations that are upon the earth.

PSALM 135:4

4 For the LORD hath chosen Jacob unto himself, and Israel for his **peculiar** treasure.

MALACHI 3:17

17 And they shall be mine, saith the LORD of hosts, in that day when I make up my **jewels**; and I will spare them, as a man spareth his own son that serveth him.

EXODUS 15:16

16 Fear and dread shall fall upon them; by the greatness of thine arm they shall be as still as a stone; till thy people pass over, O LORD, till the **people** pass over, which thou **hast purchased**.

PSALM 74:2

2 Remember thy **congregation**, which thou hast **purchased** of old; the rod of thine inheritance, which thou hast redeemed; this mount Zion, wherein thou hast dwelt.

ACTS 20:28

28 Take heed therefore unto yourselves, and to all the flock, over the which the Holy Ghost hath made you overseers, to feed the church of God, which **he hath purchased with his own blood**.

I CORINTHIANS 6:20

20 For ye are **bought with a price**: therefore glorify God in your body, and in your spirit, which are God's.

EXODUS 15:13

13 Thou in thy mercy hast led forth the people which **thou hast redeemed**: thou hast guided them in thy strength unto thy holy habitation.

DEUTERONOMY 21:8

8 Be merciful, O LORD, unto thy people Israel, whom **thou hast redeemed**, and lay not innocent blood unto thy people of Israel's charge. And the blood shall be forgiven them.

LUKE 1:68

68 Blessed be the Lord God of Israel; for he hath visited and **redeemed his people**,

GALATIANS 3:13

13 **Christ hath redeemed us** from the curse of the law, being made a curse for us: for it is written, Cursed is every one that hangeth on a tree:

GALATIANS 3:14

14 That the blessing of Abraham might come on the Gentiles through Jesus Christ; that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith.

REVELATION 5:9

9 And they sung a new song, saying, Thou art worthy to take the book, and to open the seals thereof: for thou wast slain, and **hast redeemed us** to God by thy blood out of every kindred, and tongue, and people, and nation;

DEUTERONOMY 14:2

2 For thou art **an holy people** unto the LORD thy God, and the LORD hath chosen thee to be a peculiar people unto himself, above all the nations that are upon the earth.

DEUTERONOMY 26:16

16 ¶ This day the LORD thy God hath commanded thee to do these statutes and judgments: thou shalt therefore keep and do them with all thine heart, and with all thy soul.

DEUTERONOMY 26:17

17 Thou hast avouched the LORD this day to be thy God, and to walk in his ways, and to keep his statutes, and his commandments, and his judgments, and to hearken unto his voice:

DEUTERONOMY 26:18

18 And the LORD hath avouched thee this day to be his peculiar people, as he hath promised thee, and that thou shouldest keep all his commandments;

DEUTERONOMY 26:19

19 And to make thee high above all nations which he hath made, in praise, and in name, and in honour; and that thou mayest be an **holy people** unto the LORD thy God, as he hath spoken.

DEUTERONOMY 28:9

9 The LORD shall establish thee **an holy people unto himself**, as he hath sworn unto thee, if thou shalt keep the commandments of the LORD thy God, and walk in his ways.

I PETER 1:14

14 As obedient children, not ***FASHIONING** yourselves according to the former lusts in your ignorance:

FASHIONING: suschematizo {soos-khay-mat-id'-zo conform to, fashion (one's) self according to, to conform one's self (i.e. one's mind and character) to another's pattern, (fashion one's self according to) to shape one thing like another and describes what is transitory, changeable, and unstable.

I PETER 1:15

15 But as he which hath called you is holy, so be ye holy in all manner of conversation;

I PETER 1:16

16 Because it is written, **Be ye holy; for I am holy.**

TITUS 2:13

13 Looking for that blessed hope, and the glorious appearing of the great God and our Saviour Jesus Christ;

TITUS 2:14

14 Who gave himself for us, that he might redeem us from all iniquity, and purify unto himself a ***PECULIAR** people, ***ZEALOUS** of **good works**.

PECULIAR: periousios {per-ee-oo'-see-os}
that which is one's own, belonging to one's possessions: a people selected by God from the other nations for his own possession

ZEALOUS: zelotes {dzay-lo-tace'}
one burning with zeal; a zealot, used of God as jealous of any rival and sternly vindicating his control:) most eagerly desirous of, zealous for, a thing, to acquire a thing, (zealous of), to defend and uphold a thing, vehemently contending for a thing

HEBREWS 4:8

8 For if Jesus had given them rest, then would he not afterward have spoken of another day.

HEBREWS 4:9

9 There remaineth therefore a rest to **the people of God**.

HEBREWS 11:24

24 By faith Moses, when he was come to years, refused to be called the son of Pharaoh's daughter;

HEBREWS 11:25

25 Choosing rather to suffer affliction with the people of God, than to enjoy the pleasures of sin for a season;

I PETER 2:9

9 But ye are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, an holy nation, a peculiar people; that ye should shew forth the praises of him who hath called you out of darkness into his marvellous light:

I PETER 2:10

10 Which in time past were not a people, but are **now the people of God**: which had not obtained mercy, but now have obtained mercy.
