WHAT ABOUT HISTORY?

Dictionary of the Bible by James Hastings, Thirteenth Edition, Vol. 1, p. 241 -The original form of words was into the Name of Jesus Christ" or "the Lord Jesus." Baptism into the Trinity was a later development. (Also see Hastings' Dictionary of the Bible, Revised Edition. Vol. 1, p. 88.)

Canney Encyclopedia, p. 53 The early church always baptized in the Name of the Lord Jesus until the development of the Trinity, afterward they were baptized in the Name of the Father, Son and Holy Ghost.

New Catholic Encyclopedia, 1977 Edition, Vol. 13, p. 1012 the first use of the Latin ward "trinitas" (trinity) with reference to God is found in Tertullian's writings (about 213 A. D.).

He was the first to use the term "persons" (plural) in a Trinitarian context. (Also see Encyclopedia Americana, 1983 Edition, Vol. 26, p. 527.)

Encyclopedia Americana, 1957 Edition, Vol. 27, p. 69 The word "Trinity" is not in Scripture. The term persons (plural) is not applied in Scripture to the Trinity.

World Book Encyclopedia, 1984 Edition, Vol. T, p. 363 Belief in Father, Son and Holy Ghost was first defined by the earliest general council of churches.

This was the First Council of Nicaea in 325 A. D. (For Nicene Creed see Encyclopedia Americana, 1983 Edition, Vol. 20, p. 310.)

Brittanica Encyclopedia, Eleventh Edition, Vol. 3, p. 365, 366 The triune and trinity formula was not used from the beginning, and up until the third century, baptism in the Name of Christ only was wide-spread ...

(Baptismal formula changed by the Roman Catholic Church). Now the formula of Rome is "I baptize thee in the Name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Ghost. ' New International Encyclopedia, Vol. 22, p. 476 The Trinity doctrine. The Catholic Faith is this, We worship one in trinity, but there is one person of the Father, another of the Son and another of the Holy Ghost. They Glory equal the Majesty coeternal.

The doctrine is not found in its fully developed form in the Scriptures. Modern theology does not seek to find it in the Old Testament. At the time of the Reformation the Protestant Church took over the doctrine of the Trinity without serious examination.

Encyclopedia International, 1982 Edition, Vol. 18, p. 226 The doctrine of the Trinity did not form part of the apostles' preaching, as this is reported in the New Testament.
