122 Now, the 8th chapter of Leviticus, and I've got marked down here the 10th verse. Note Leviticus 8 and 10. Let's see.

And Moses took the anointing oil, and poured anointing oil--and anointed the tabernacle and all that was therein, and sanctified them.

And he sprinkled thereof upon the altar seven times,. . . anointed the altar and all the vessels, both the laver and his foot, to the--to sanctify them. And he poured. . . anointing oil upon Aaron's head, and anointed him, to sanctify him.

Moses in the wilderness sanctifying or anointing the tabernacle of worship for the children of Israel when they were in their journey.
. . . It was anointed.

124. we notice that New Jerusalem is the most holy place, and the anointing will be upon the New Jerusalem that descends from God out of heaven,

prepared as a bride adorned for her husband. The anointing will be upon them.

In the fifth year of his own exile from Jerusalem, that is in 593 BC, Ezekiel was called by God to exercise a prophetic ministry to the house of Israel which he continued until about the year 570.

Ezekiel was married, in fact his wife died as a sign from God on the day the siege of Jerusalem began, (24:18).

He gives 318 precise measurements of the temple using some 37 unique words that are architectural terms, such as "door-posts," "windows," etc.

EZEKIEL 40:1

1 In the five and twentieth year of our captivity, in the beginning of the year, in the tenth day of the month, in the fourteenth year after that the city was smitten,

in the selfsame day the hand of the LORD was upon me, and brought me thither.

EZEKIEL 40:2

2 In the visions of God brought he me into the land of Israel, and set me upon a very high mountain, by which was as the frame of a city on the south.

EZEKIEL 40:3

3 And he brought me thither, and, behold, there was a man, whose appearance was like the appearance of brass, with a line of flax in his hand, and a measuring reed; and he stood in the gate.

EZEKIEL 40:4

4 And the man said unto me, Son of man, behold with thine eyes, and hear with thine ears, and set thine heart upon all that I shall shew thee;

for to the intent that I might shew them unto thee art thou brought hither: declare all that thou seest to the house of Israel.

EZEKIEL 42:15

15 Now when he had made an end of measuring the inner house, he brought me forth toward the gate whose prospect is toward the east, and measured it round about.

EZEKIEL 42:16

16 He measured the east side with the measuring reed, five hundred reeds, with the measuring reed round about.

EZEKIEL 42:17

17 He measured the north side, five hundred reeds, with the measuring reed round about.

EZEKIEL 42:18

18 He measured the south side, five hundred reeds, with the measuring reed.

EZEKIEL 42:19

19 He turned about to the west side, and measured five hundred reeds with the measuring reed.

EZEKIEL 42:20

20 He measured it by the four sides: it had a wall round about, five hundred reeds long, and five hundred broad, to make a separation between the sanctuary and the profane place.

EZEKIEL 43:1

1 Afterward he brought me to the gate, even the gate that looketh toward the east:

EZEKIEL 43:2

2 And, behold, the glory of the God of Israel came from the way of the east: and his voice was like a noise of many waters: and the earth shined with his glory.

EZEKIEL 43:3

3 And it was according to the appearance of the vision which I saw, even according to the vision that I saw when I came to destroy the city: and the visions were like the vision that I saw by the river Chebar; and I fell upon my face.

EZEKIEL 43:4

4 And the glory of the LORD came into the house by the way of the gate whose prospect is toward the east.

EZEKIEL 43:5

5 So the spirit took me up, and brought me into the inner court; and, behold, the glory of the LORD filled the house.

EZEKIEL 43:7

7 And he said unto me, Son of man, the place of my throne, and the place of the soles of my feet, where I will dwell in the midst of the children of Israel for ever,

and my holy name, shall the house of Israel no more defile, neither they, nor their kings, by their whoredom, nor by the carcasses of their kings in their high places.

EZEKIEL 47:1

1 Afterward he brought me again unto the door of the house; and, behold, waters issued out from under the threshold of the house eastward:

for the forefront of the house stood toward the east, and the waters came down from under from the right side of the house, at the south side of the altar.

EZEKIEL 47:2

2 Then brought he me out of the way of the gate northward, and led me about the way without unto the utter gate by the way that looketh eastward; and, behold, there ran out waters on the right side.

EZEKIEL 47:7

7 Now when I had returned, behold, at the bank of the river were very many trees on the one side and on the other.

EZEKIEL 47:8

8 Then said he unto me, These waters issue out toward the east country, and go down into the desert, and go into the sea: which being brought forth into the sea, the waters shall be healed.

EZEKIEL 47:12

12 And by the river upon the bank thereof, on this side and on that side, shall grow all trees for meat, whose leaf shall not fade, neither shall the fruit thereof be consumed:

it shall bring forth new fruit according to his months, because their waters they issued out of the sanctuary: and the fruit thereof shall be for meat, and the leaf thereof for medicine.

EZEKIEL 48:30

30 And these are the goings out of the city on the north side, four thousand and five hundred measures.

EZEKIEL 48:31

31 And the gates of the city shall be after the names of the tribes of Israel: three gates northward; one gate of Reuben, one gate of Judah, one gate of Levi.

EZEKIEL 48:32

32 And at the east side four thousand and five hundred: and three gates; and one gate of Joseph, one gate of Benjamin, one gate of Dan.

EZEKIEL 48:33

33 And at the south side four thousand and five hundred measures: and three gates; one gate of Simeon, one gate of Issachar, one gate of Zebulun.

EZEKIEL 48:34

34 At the west side four thousand and five hundred, with their three gates; one gate of Gad, one gate of Asher, one gate of Naphtali.

EZEKIEL 48:35

35 It was round about eighteen thousand measures: and the name of the city from that day shall be, The LORD is there.
