PSALM 45:1

1 ¶ To the chief Musician upon Shoshannim, for the sons of Korah, Maschil, A Song of loves. My heart is inditing a good matter: I speak of the things which I have made touching the king: my tongue is the pen of a ready writer.

PSALM 45:2

2 Thou art fairer than the children of men: grace is poured into thy lips: therefore God hath blessed thee for ever.

PSALM 45:3

3 Gird thy sword upon thy thigh, O most mighty, with thy glory and thy majesty.

PSALM 45:4

4 And in thy majesty ride prosperously because of truth and meekness and righteousness; and thy right hand shall teach thee terrible things.

PSALM 45:5

5 Thine arrows are sharp in the heart of the king's enemies; whereby the people fall under thee.

PSALM 45:6

6 ¶ Thy throne, **O God**, is for ever and ever: the sceptre of thy kingdom is a right sceptre.

PSALM 45:7

7 Thou lovest righteousness, and hatest wickedness: therefore God, thy God, hath anointed thee with the oil of gladness above thy fellows.

PSALM 45:8

8 All thy garments smell of myrrh, and aloes, and cassia, out of the ivory palaces, whereby they have made thee glad.

PSALM 45:9

9 Kings' daughters were among thy honourable women: upon thy right hand did stand the queen in gold of Ophir.

PSALM 45:10

10 ¶ Hearken, O daughter, and consider, and incline thine ear; forget also thine own people, and thy father's house;

PSALM 45:11

11 So shall the king greatly desire thy beauty: for he is thy Lord; and worship thou him.

PSALM 45:12

12 And the daughter of Tyre shall be there with a gift; even the rich among the people shall intreat thy favour.

PSALM 45:13

13 The king's daughter is all glorious within: her clothing is of wrought gold.

PSALM 45:14

14 She shall be brought **unto the king** in raiment of needlework: the virgins her companions that follow her shall be brought unto thee.

PSALM 45:15

15 With gladness and rejoicing shall they be brought: they shall enter into the king's palace.

PSALM 45:16

16 Instead of thy fathers shall be thy children, whom thou mayest **make princes in all the earth.**

PSALM 45:17

17 I will make thy name to be remembered in all generations: therefore shall the people praise thee for ever and ever.

PSALM 46:1

1 ¶ To the chief Musician for the sons of Korah, A Song upon Alamoth. God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble.

PSALM 46:2

2 Therefore will not we fear, though the earth be removed, and though the mountains be carried into the midst of the sea;

PSALM 46:3

3 Though the waters thereof roar and be troubled, though the mountains shake with the swelling thereof. Selah.

PSALM 46:4

4 There is a river, the streams whereof shall make glad the city of God, the holy place of the tabernacles of the most High.

PSALM 46:5

5 **God is in the midst of her;** she shall not be moved: God shall help her, and that right early.

PSALM 46:6

6 ¶ The heathen raged, the kingdoms were moved: he uttered his voice, **the earth melted.**

PSALM 46:7

7 The LORD of hosts is with us; the God of Jacob is our refuge. Selah.

PSALM 46:8

8 Come, behold the works of the LORD, what desolations he hath made in the earth.

PSALM 46:9

9 He maketh wars to cease unto the end of the earth; he breaketh the bow, and cutteth the spear in sunder; he burneth the chariot in the fire.

PSALM 46:10

10 Be still, and know that I am God: I will be exalted among the heathen, I will be exalted in the earth.

PSALM 46:11

11 The LORD of hosts is with us; the God of Jacob is our refuge. Selah.

REVELATION 13:1

1 ¶ And I stood upon the sand of the sea, and saw a beast rise up out of the sea, having seven heads and ten horns, and upon his horns ten crowns, and upon his heads the name of blasphemy.

REVELATION 13:2

2 And the beast which I saw was like unto a leopard, and his feet were as the feet of a bear, and his mouth as the mouth of a lion: and the dragon gave him his power, and his seat, and great authority.

REVELATION 13:3

3 And I saw one of his heads as it were wounded to death; and his deadly wound was healed: and all the world wondered after the beast.

REVELATION 13:11

11 ¶ And I beheld another beast coming up out of the earth; and he had two horns like a lamb, and he spake as a dragon.

REVELATION 13:12

12 And he exerciseth all the power of the first beast before him, and causeth the earth and them which dwell therein to worship the first beast, whose deadly wound was healed.

REVELATION 13:15

15 And he had power to give life unto the image of the beast, that the image of the beast should both speak, and cause

that as many as would not worship the image of the beast should be killed.

REVELATION 19:21

21 And the remnant were slain with the sword of him that sat upon the horse, which sword proceeded out of his mouth: and all the fowls were filled with their flesh.

ZECHARIAH 14:2

2 For I will gather all nations against Jerusalem to battle; and the city shall be taken, and the houses rifled, and the women ravished; and half of the city shall go forth into captivity, and the residue of the people shall not be cut off from the city.

ZECHARIAH 14:3

3 Then shall the LORD go forth, and fight against those nations, as when he fought in the day of battle.

ZECHARIAH 14:4

4 And his feet shall stand in that day upon the mount of Olives, which is before Jerusalem on the east, and the mount of Olives shall cleave in the midst thereof toward the east and toward the west, and there shall be a very great valley; and half of the mountain shall remove toward the north, and half of it toward the south.

REVELATION 19:11

11 ¶ And I saw heaven opened, and behold a white horse; and he that sat upon him was called Faithful and True, and in righteousness he doth judge and make war.

REVELATION 19:12

12 His eyes were as a flame of fire, and on his head were many crowns; and he had a name written, that no man knew, but he himself.

REVELATION 19:13

13 And he was clothed with a vesture dipped in blood: and his name is called The Word of God.

REVELATION 19:14

14 And the armies which were in heaven followed him upon white horses, clothed in fine linen, white and clean.

REVELATION 19:15

15 And out of his mouth goeth a sharp sword, that with it he should smite the nations: and he shall rule them with a rod of iron: and he treadeth the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God.

REVELATION 19:16

16 And he hath on his vesture and on his thigh a name written, KING OF KINGS, AND LORD OF LORDS.

I CHRONICLES 22:9

9 Behold, a son shall be born to thee, who shall be **a man of rest**; and I will give him **rest** from all his enemies round about: for his name shall be ***SOLOMON**, and I will give **peace** and **quietness** unto Israel in his days.

Solomon = "peace"

I CHRONICLES 22:10

10 He shall build an house for my name; and he shall be my son, and I will be his father; and I will establish the throne of his kingdom over Israel for ever.

I KINGS 4:24

24 For he had dominion over all the region on this side the river, from Tiphshah even to Azzah, over all the kings on this side the river: and he had peace on all sides round about him.

1 ¶ To the chief Musician, A Psalm for the sons of Korah. O clap your hands, all ye people; shout unto God with the voice of triumph.

PSALM 47:2

2 For the LORD most high is terrible; he is a great King over all the earth.

PSALM 47:3

3 He shall subdue the people under us, and the nations under our feet.

PSALM 47:4

4 He shall choose our inheritance for us, the excellency of Jacob whom he loved. Selah.

PSALM 47:5

5 ¶ God is gone up with a shout, the LORD with the sound of a trumpet.

PSALM 47:6

6 Sing praises to God, sing praises: sing praises unto our King, sing praises.

PSALM 47:7

7 For God is the King of all the earth: sing ye praises with understanding.

PSALM 47:8

8 **God reigneth over the heathen:** God sitteth upon the throne of his holiness.

PSALM 47:9

9 **The princes of the people** are gathered together, even **the people of the God of Abraham**: for the shields of the earth belong unto God: he is greatly exalted.

PSALM 48:1

1 ¶ A Song and Psalm for the sons of Korah. Great is the LORD, and greatly to be praised in the city of our God, in the mountain of his holiness.

PSALM 48:2

2 Beautiful for situation, the joy of the whole earth, is mount Zion, on the sides of the north, the city of the great King.

PSALM 48:3

3 God is known in her palaces for a refuge.

PSALM 48:4

4 For, lo, the kings were assembled, they passed by together.

PSALM 48:5

5 They saw it, and so they marvelled; they were troubled, and hasted away.

PSALM 48:6

6 Fear took hold upon them there, and pain, as of a woman in travail.

PSALM 48:7

7 Thou breakest the ships of Tarshish with an east wind.

PSALM 48:8

8 ¶ As we have heard, so have we seen in the city of the LORD of hosts, in the city of our God: God will establish it for ever. Selah.

PSALM 48:9

9 We have thought of thy lovingkindness, O God, in the midst of thy temple.

PSALM 48:10

10 According to thy name, O God, so is thy praise unto the ends of the earth: thy right hand is full of righteousness.

PSALM 48:11

11 Let mount Zion rejoice, let the daughters of Judah be glad, because of thy judgments.

PSALM 48:12

12 Walk about Zion, and go round about her: tell the towers thereof.

PSALM 48:13

13 Mark ye well her bulwarks, consider her palaces; that ye may tell it to the generation following.

PSALM 48:14

14 For this God is our God for ever and ever: he will be our guide even unto death.

PSALM 67:1

1 ¶ To the chief Musician on Neginoth, A Psalm or Song.
God be merciful unto us, and bless us; and cause his face to
shine upon us; Selah.

PSALM 67:2

2 That thy way may be known upon earth, thy saving health
among all nations.

PSALM 67:3

3 Let the people praise thee, O God; let all the people praise
thee.

PSALM 67:4

4 O let the nations be glad and sing for joy: for thou shalt
judge the people righteously, and govern the nations upon earth.
Selah.

PSALM 67:5

5 Let the people praise thee, O God; let all the people praise
thee.

PSALM 67:6

6 Then shall the earth yield her increase; and God, even our
own God, shall bless us.

PSALM 67:7

7 God shall bless us; and all the ends of the earth shall fear
him.

PSALM 72:1

1 ¶ A Psalm for Solomon. Give the king thy judgments, O
God, and thy righteousness unto the king's son.

PSALM 72:2

2 ¶ He shall judge thy people with righteousness, and thy
poor with judgment.

PSALM 72:3

3 The mountains shall bring peace to the people, and the little hills, by righteousness.

PSALM 72:4

4 He shall judge the poor of the people, he shall save the children of the needy, and shall break in pieces the oppressor.

PSALM 72:5

5 They shall fear thee as long as the sun and moon endure, throughout all generations.

PSALM 72:6

6 He shall come down like rain upon the mown grass: as showers that water the earth.

PSALM 72:7

7 In his days shall the righteous flourish; and abundance of peace so long as the moon endureth.

PSALM 72:8

8 He shall have dominion also from sea to sea, and from the river unto the ends of the earth.

PSALM 72:9

9 They that dwell in the wilderness shall bow before him; and his enemies shall lick the dust.

PSALM 72:10

10 The kings of Tarshish and of the isles shall bring presents: the kings of Sheba and Seba shall offer gifts.

PSALM 72:11

11 Yea, all kings shall fall down before him: all nations shall serve him.

PSALM 72:12

12 For he shall deliver the needy when he crieth; the poor also, and him that hath no helper.

PSALM 72:13

13 He shall spare the poor and needy, and shall save the souls of the needy.

PSALM 72:14

14 He shall redeem their soul from deceit and violence: and precious shall their blood be in his sight.

PSALM 72:15

15 And he shall live, and to him shall be given of the gold of Sheba: prayer also shall be made for him continually; **and daily shall he be praised.**

PSALM 72:16

16 There shall be an handful of corn in the earth upon the top of the mountains; the fruit thereof shall shake like Lebanon: and they of the city shall flourish like grass of the earth.

PSALM 72:17

17 His name shall endure for ever: his name shall be continued as long as the sun: and men shall be blessed in him: **all nations** shall call him blessed.

PSALM 72:18

18 ¶ Blessed be the LORD God, the God of Israel, who only doeth wondrous things.

PSALM 72:19

19 And blessed be his glorious name for ever: and **let the whole earth be filled with his glory;** Amen, and Amen.

PSALM 72:20

20 The prayers of David the son of Jesse are ended.
