PSALM 46:7

7 The LORD of hosts is with us; the God of Jacob is our refuge. Selah.

PSALM 46:8

8 Come, behold the works of the LORD, what desolations he hath made in the earth.

PSALM 46:9

9 He maketh wars to cease unto the end of the earth; he breaketh the bow, and cutteth the spear in sunder; he burneth the chariot in the fire.

PSALM 46:10

10 Be still, and know that I am God: I will be exalted among the heathen, I will be exalted in the earth.

PSALM 46:11

11 The LORD of hosts is with us; the God of Jacob is our refuge. Selah.

ISAIAH 14:1

1 ¶ For the LORD will have mercy on Jacob, and will yet choose Israel, and **set them in their own land:** and the strangers shall be **joined with them,** and they shall cleave to the house of Jacob.

ISAIAH 14:3

3 And it shall come to pass in the day that the LORD shall give thee rest from thy sorrow, and from thy fear, and from the hard bondage wherein thou wast made to serve,

ISAIAH 14:4

4 ¶ That thou shalt take up this proverb against the king of Babylon, and say, How hath the oppressor ceased! the golden city ceased!

ISAIAH 14:5

5 The LORD hath broken the staff of the wicked, and the sceptre of the rulers.

ISAIAH 14:6

6 He who smote the people in wrath with a continual stroke, he that ruled the nations in anger, is persecuted, and none hindereth.

ISAIAH 14:7

7 The whole earth is at rest, and is quiet: they break forth into singing.

ISAIAH 14:8

8 Yea, the fir trees rejoice at thee, and the cedars of Lebanon, saying, Since thou art laid down, no feller is come up against us.

ISAIAH 24:23

23 Then the moon shall be confounded, and the sun ashamed, when the LORD of hosts **shall reign in mount Zion**, and in Jerusalem, and before his ancients gloriously.

ISAIAH 25:6

6 ¶ And in this mountain shall the LORD of hosts make unto all people a feast of fat things, a feast of wines on the lees, of fat things full of marrow, of wines on the lees well refined.

ISAIAH 25:7

7 And he will destroy in this mountain the face of the covering cast over all people, and the vail that is spread over all nations.

ISAIAH 25:8

8 He will swallow up death in victory; and the Lord GOD will wipe away tears from off all faces; and the rebuke of his people shall he take away from off all the earth: for the LORD hath spoken it.

ISAIAH 25:9

9 ¶ And it shall be said in that day, Lo, this is our God; we have waited for him, and he will save us: this is the LORD; we have waited for him, we will be glad and rejoice in his salvation.

ISAIAH 26:1

1 ¶ In that day shall this song be sung in the land of Judah; We have a strong city; salvation will God appoint for walls and bulwarks.

ISAIAH 26:2

2 Open ye the gates, that the righteous nation which keepeth the truth may enter in.

ISAIAH 26:3

3 Thou wilt keep him in perfect peace, whose mind is stayed on thee: because he trusteth in thee.

ISAIAH 26:4

4 Trust ye in the LORD for ever: for in the LORD JEHOVAH is everlasting strength:

ISAIAH 26:5

5 ¶ For he bringeth down them that dwell on high; the lofty city, he layeth it low; he layeth it low, even to the ground; he bringeth it even to the dust.

ISAIAH 27:12

12 And it shall come to pass in that day, that the LORD shall beat off from the channel of the river unto the stream of Egypt, and ye shall be gathered one by one, O ye children of Israel.

ISAIAH 27:13

13 And it shall come to pass in that day, that the great trumpet shall be blown, and they shall come which were ready to perish in the land of Assyria, and the outcasts in the land of Egypt, **and shall worship the LORD in the holy mount at Jerusalem.**

ISAIAH 56:6

6 Also the sons of the stranger, that join themselves to the LORD, to serve him, and to love the name of the LORD, to be his servants, every one that keepeth the sabbath from polluting it, and taketh hold of my covenant;

ISAIAH 56:7

7 Even them will I bring **to my holy mountain**, and make them joyful in my house of prayer: their burnt offerings and their sacrifices shall be accepted upon mine altar; for mine house shall be called an house of prayer for all people.

ISAIAH 56:8

8 The Lord GOD which gathereth the outcasts of Israel saith, **Yet will I gather others to him**, beside those that are gathered unto him.

ISAIAH 65:17

17 ¶ For, behold, I create new heavens and a new earth: and the former shall not be remembered, nor come into mind.

ISAIAH 65:18

18 But be ye glad and rejoice for ever in that which I create: for, behold, I create Jerusalem a rejoicing, and her people a joy.

ISAIAH 65:19

19 And I will rejoice in Jerusalem, and joy in my people: and the voice of weeping shall be no more heard in her, nor the voice of crying.

ISAIAH 65:20

20 There shall be no more thence an infant of days, nor an old man that hath not filled his days: for the child shall die an hundred years old; but the sinner being an hundred years old shall be accursed.

ISAIAH 65:21

21 And they shall build houses, and inhabit them; and they shall plant vineyards, and eat the fruit of them.

ISAIAH 65:22

22 They shall not build, and another inhabit; they shall not plant, and another eat: for as the days of a tree are the days of my people, and mine elect shall long enjoy the work of their hands.

MICAH 4:3

3 And he shall judge among many people, and rebuke strong nations afar off; and they shall beat their swords into plowshares, and their spears into pruninghooks: nation shall not lift up a sword against nation, neither shall they learn war any more.

MICAH 4:4

4 But they shall sit every man **under his vine and under his fig tree**; and none shall make them afraid: for the mouth of the LORD of hosts hath spoken it.

ZECHARIAH 3:10

10 In that day, saith the LORD of hosts, shall ye call every man his neighbour under the vine and under the fig tree.

ISAIAH 65:23

23 They shall not labour in vain, nor bring forth for trouble; for they are the seed of the blessed of the LORD, and their offspring with them.

ISAIAH 65:24

24 And it shall come to pass, that before they call, I will answer; and while they are yet speaking, I will hear.

ISAIAH 65:25

25 The wolf and the lamb shall feed together, and the lion shall eat straw like the bullock: and dust shall be the serpent's meat. They shall not hurt nor destroy in all my holy mountain, saith the LORD.

ISAIAH 30:23

23 Then shall he give the rain of thy seed, that thou shalt sow the ground withal; and bread of the increase of the earth, and **it shall be fat and plenteous**: in that day shall thy cattle feed in large pastures.

ISAIAH 30:24

24 The oxen likewise and the young asses that ear the ground shall eat clean provender, which hath been winnowed with the shovel and with the fan.

ISAIAH 35:7

7 And the parched ground shall become a pool, and the thirsty land springs of water: in the habitation of dragons, where each lay, shall be grass with reeds and rushes.

ISAIAH 35:8

8 And an highway shall be there, and a way, and it shall be called The way of holiness; the unclean shall not pass over it; but it shall be for those: the wayfaring men, though fools, shall not err therein.

ISAIAH 35:9

9 No lion shall be there, nor any ravenous beast shall go up thereon, it shall not be found there; but the redeemed shall walk there:

ISAIAH 35:10

10 And the ransomed of the LORD shall return, and come to Zion with songs and everlasting joy upon their heads: they shall obtain joy and gladness, and sorrow and sighing shall flee away.

ZEPHANIAH 3:14

14 ¶ Sing, O daughter of Zion; shout, O Israel; be glad and rejoice with all the heart, O daughter of Jerusalem.

ZEPHANIAH 3:15

15 The LORD hath taken away thy judgments, he hath cast out thine enemy: the king of Israel, even the LORD, is in the midst of thee: thou shalt not see evil any more.

ZEPHANIAH 3:16

16 In that day it shall be said to Jerusalem, Fear thou not: and to Zion, Let not thine hands be slack.

ZEPHANIAH 3:17

17 The LORD thy God in the midst of thee is mighty; he will save, he will rejoice over thee with joy; he will rest in his love, he will joy over thee with singing.

JEREMIAH 33:15

15 In those days, and at that time, will I cause the Branch of righteousness to grow up unto David; and he shall execute judgment and righteousness in the land.

JEREMIAH 33:16

16 In those days shall Judah be saved, and Jerusalem shall dwell safely: and this is the name wherewith she shall be called, The LORD our righteousness.

JEREMIAH 23:5

5 Behold, the days come, saith the LORD, that I will raise unto David a righteous Branch, and a King shall reign and prosper, and shall execute judgment and justice in the earth.

JEREMIAH 23:6

6 In his days Judah shall be saved, and Israel shall dwell safely: and this is his name whereby he shall be called, THE LORD OUR RIGHTEOUSNESS.

EZEKIEL 43:7

7 ¶ And he said unto me, Son of man, **the place of my throne**, and the place of the soles of my feet, **where I will dwell in the midst of the children of Israel forever**, and my holy name, shall the house of Israel no more defile, neither they, nor their kings, by their whoredom, nor by the carcasses of their kings in their high places.

EZEKIEL 43:8

8 In their setting of their threshold by my thresholds, and their post by my posts, and the wall between me and them, they have even defiled my holy name by their abominations that they have committed: wherefore I have consumed them in mine anger.

EZEKIEL 43:9

9 Now let them put away their whoredom, and the carcasses of their kings, far from me, **and I will dwell in the midst of them forever.**

REVELATION 21:3

3 And I heard a great voice out of heaven saying, Behold, the tabernacle of God is with men, and he will dwell with them, and they shall be his people, and God himself shall be with them, and be their God.

EZEKIEL 43:1

1 ¶ Afterward he brought me to the gate, even the gate that looketh toward the east:

EZEKIEL 43:2

2 And, behold, the glory of the God of Israel came from the way of the east: and his voice was like a noise of many waters: and the earth shined with his glory.

EZEKIEL 43:3

3 And it was according to the appearance of the vision which I saw, even according to the vision that I saw when I came to destroy the city: and the visions were like the vision that I saw by the river Chebar; and I fell upon my face.

EZEKIEL 43:4

4 And the glory of the LORD came into the house by the way of the gate whose prospect is toward the east.

REVELATION 21:10

10 And he carried me away in the spirit to a great and high mountain, and shewed me that great city, the holy Jerusalem, descending out of heaven from God,

REVELATION 21:11

11 Having the glory of God: and her light was like unto a stone most precious, even like a jasper stone, clear as crystal;

EZEKIEL 47:1

1 ¶ Afterward he brought me again unto the door of the house; and, behold, waters issued out from under the threshold of the house eastward: for the forefront of the house stood toward the east, and the waters came down from under from the right side of the house, at the south side of the altar.

EZEKIEL 47:2

2 Then brought he me out of the way of the gate northward, and led me about the way without unto the utter gate by the way that looketh eastward; and, behold, there ran out waters on the right side.

REVELATION 22:1

1 ¶ And he shewed me a pure river of water of life, clear as crystal, proceeding out of the throne of God and of the Lamb.

REVELATION 22:2

2 In the midst of the street of it, and on either side of the river, was there the tree of life, which bare twelve manner of fruits, and yielded her fruit every month: and the leaves of the tree were for the healing of the nations.

EZEKIEL 48:30

30 And these are the goings out of the city on the north side, four thousand and five hundred measures.

EZEKIEL 48:31

31 ¶ And the gates of the city shall be after the names of the tribes of Israel: three gates northward; one gate of Reuben, one gate of Judah, one gate of Levi.

EZEKIEL 48:32

32 And at the east side four thousand and five hundred: and three gates; and one gate of Joseph, one gate of Benjamin, one gate of Dan.

EZEKIEL 48:33

33 And at the south side four thousand and five hundred measures: and three gates; one gate of Simeon, one gate of Issachar, one gate of Zebulun.

EZEKIEL 48:34

34 At the west side four thousand and five hundred, with their three gates; one gate of Gad, one gate of Asher, one gate of Naphtali.

REVELATION 21:12

12 And had a wall great and high, and had twelve gates, and at the gates twelve angels, and names written thereon, which are the names of the twelve tribes of the children of Israel:

REVELATION 21:13

13 On the east three gates; on the north three gates; on the south three gates; and on the west three gates.

REVELATION 21:14

14 And the wall of the city had twelve foundations, and in them the names of the twelve apostles of the Lamb.

EZEKIEL 47:12

12 And by the river upon the bank thereof, on this side and on that side, shall grow all trees for meat, whose leaf shall not fade, neither shall the fruit thereof be consumed: it shall bring forth new fruit according to his months, because their waters they issued out of the sanctuary: and the fruit thereof shall be for meat, and the leaf thereof for medicine.

REVELATION 22:2

2 In the midst of the street of it, and on either side of the river, was there the tree of life, which bare twelve manner of fruits, and yielded her fruit every month: and the leaves of the tree were for the healing of the nations.

399 And all up-and-down here, will be the Redeemed. There will be the houses of pure gold. There will be avenues, and parks, and gardens. ISAIAH 2:2

2 And it shall come to pass in the last days, that the mountain of the LORD'S house shall be established in the top of the mountains, and shall be exalted above the hills; and all nations shall flow unto it.

ISAIAH 2:3

3 And many people shall go and say, Come ye, and let us go up to the mountain of the LORD, to the house of the God of Jacob; and he will teach us of his ways, and we will walk in his paths: for out of Zion shall go forth the law, and the word of the LORD from Jerusalem.

The first temple, sometimes called Solomon's Temple, was constructed during the reign of Solomon (970 B.C. to 930 B.C.). This temple was destroyed nearly 400 years later, in 586 B.C.. The destruction, at the hands of Nebuchadnezzar, occurred on the 9th of AV. Av is the 5th month in the Jewish calendar, and equates to August in our calendar.

The second temple's construction was begun by Zerubbabel and Ezra in about 538 B.C. This temple was remodeled and expanded by Herod the Great. That renovation took 46 years - from 19 B.C. to 27 A. D.

The second temple was the Temple in which Jesus was dedicated. This is where He often taught. It was from this temple that Jesus twice drove the money changers.

Jesus foretold the destruction of this temple some 40 years before its demise in 70 A.D., when the Roman

General Titus besieged the city of Jerusalem. It may be interesting to you that the destruction of Temple 2 occurred on the same day and month that Temple 1 was. It was on the 9th of Av.
