EZEKIEL 42:15

15 ¶ Now when he had made an end of measuring the inner house, he brought me forth toward the gate whose prospect is toward the east, and measured it round about.

EZEKIEL 42:16

16 He measured the east side with the measuring reed, five hundred reeds, with the measuring reed round about.

EZEKIEL 42:17

17 He measured the north side, five hundred reeds, with the measuring reed round about.

EZEKIEL 42:18

18 He measured the south side, five hundred reeds, with the measuring reed.

EZEKIEL 42:19

19 He turned about to the west side, and measured five hundred reeds with the measuring reed.

EZEKIEL 42:20

20 He measured it by the four sides: it had a wall round about, five hundred reeds long, and five hundred broad, to make a separation between the sanctuary and the profane place.

EZEKIEL 43:1

1 ¶ Afterward he brought me to the gate, even the gate that looketh toward the east:

PEZEKIEL 43:2

2 And, behold, the glory of the God of Israel came from the way of the east: and his voice was like a noise of many waters: and the earth shined with his glory.

EZEKIEL 43:3

3 And it was according to the appearance of the vision which I saw, even according to the vision that I saw when I came to destroy the city: and the visions were like the vision that I saw by the river Chebar; and I fell upon my face.

EZEKIEL 43:4

4 And the glory of the LORD came into the house by the way of the gate whose prospect is toward the east.

EZEKIEL 43:5

5 So the spirit took me up, and brought me into the inner court; and, behold, the glory of the LORD filled the house.

EZEKIEL 48:30

30 And these are the goings out of the city on the north side, four thousand and five hundred measures.

EZEKIEL 48:31

31 ¶ And the gates of the city shall be after the names of the tribes of Israel: three gates northward; one gate of Reuben, one gate of Judah, one gate of Levi.

EZEKIEL 48:32

32 And at the east side four thousand and five hundred: and three gates; and one gate of Joseph, one gate of Benjamin, one gate of Dan.

EZEKIEL 48:33

33 And at the south side four thousand and five hundred measures: and three gates; one gate of Simeon, one gate of Issachar, one gate of Zebulun.

EZEKIEL 48:34

34 At the west side four thousand and five hundred, with their three gates; one gate of Gad, one gate of Asher, one gate of Naphtali.

EZEKIEL 48:35

35 It was round about eighteen thousand measures: and the name of the city from that day shall be, The LORD is there.

ZECHARIAH 8:20

20 Thus saith the LORD of hosts; It shall yet come to pass, that there shall come people, and the inhabitants of many cities:

ZECHARIAH 8:21

21 And the inhabitants of one city shall go to another, saying, Let us go speedily to pray before the LORD, and to seek the LORD of hosts: I will go also.

ZECHARIAH 8:22

30 Thus shall they know that I the LORD their God am with them, and that they, even the house of Israel, are my people, saith the Lord GOD.

EZEKIEL 34:31

31 And ye my flock, the flock of my pasture, are men, and I am your God, saith the Lord GOD.

1. THE TABERNACLE OF MOSES (EX 40). DATES: 1444-1100 B.C,

EXODUS 40:33

33 And he reared up the court round about the tabernacle and the altar, and set up the hanging of the court gate. So Moses finished the work.

EXODUS 40:34

34 ¶ Then a cloud covered the tent of the congregation, and the glory of the LORD filled the tabernacle.

EXODUS 40:35

35 And Moses was not able to enter into the tent of the congregation, because the cloud abode thereon, and the glory of the LORD filled the tabernacle.

2. THE TEMPLE OF SOLOMON (1 KINGS 6). DATES: 959-586 B.C.

I KINGS 8:10

10 And it came to pass, when the priests were come out of the holy place, that the cloud filled the house of the LORD,

I KINGS 8:11

11 So that the priests could not stand to minister because of the cloud: for the glory of the LORD had filled the house of the LORD.

I KINGS 8:12

12 ¶ Then spake Solomon, The LORD said that he would dwell in the thick darkness.

3. The Temple of Zerubbabel (Ezra 5). Note: This was later greatly enlarged by Herod (see John 2). Dates: 516 B.C.-A.D. 70

EZRA 6:16

16 And the children of Israel, the priests, and the Levites, and the rest of the children of the captivity, kept the dedication of this house of God with joy,

EZRA 6:17

17 And offered at the dedication of this house of God an hundred bullocks, two hundred rams, four hundred lambs; and for a sin offering for all Israel, twelve he goats, according to the number of the tribes of Israel.

EZRA 6:18

18 And they set the priests in their divisions, and the Levites in their courses, for the service of God, which is at Jerusalem; as it is written in the book of Moses.

4. THE TEMPLE OF CHRIST'S BODY (JOHN 2). DATES: 4 B.C.-A.D. 30

MATTHEW 3:16

16 And Jesus, when he was baptized, went up straightway out of the water: and, lo, the heavens were opened unto him, and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove, and lighting upon him:

MATTHEW 3:17

17 And lo a voice from heaven, saying, This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased.

LUKE 3:21

1 ¶ Now when all the people were baptized, it came to pass, that Jesus also being baptized, and praying, the heaven was opened,

LUKE 3:22

22 And the Holy Ghost descended in a bodily shape like a dove upon him, and a voice came from heaven, which said, Thou art my beloved Son; in thee I am well pleased.

REVELATION 21:22

22 And I saw no temple therein: for the Lord God Almighty and the Lamb are the temple of it.

MATTHEW 19:27

8 Let the floods clap their hands: let the hills be joyful together

PROVERBS 24:30

30 ¶ I went by the field of the slothful, and by the vineyard of the man void of understanding;

31 And, lo, it was all **grown over with thorns**, and nettles had covered the face thereof, and the stone wall thereof was broken down.

ISAIAH 5:5

5 And now go to; I will tell you what I will do to my vineyard: I will take away the hedge thereof, and it shall be eaten up; and break down the wall thereof, and it shall be trodden down:

ISAIAH 5:6

6 And I will lay it waste: it shall not be pruned, nor digged; but there **shall come up briers and thorns**: I will also command the clouds that they rain no rain upon it.

ISAIAH 7:23

23 And it shall come to pass in that day, that every place shall be, where there were a thousand vines at a thousand silverlings, **it shall even be for briers and thorns**.

ISAIAH 7:24

24 With arrows and with bows shall men come thither; because all **the land shall become briers and thorns**.

ISAIAH 7:25

25 And on all hills that shall be digged with the mattock, there shall not come thither **the fear of briers and thorns**: but it shall be for the sending forth of oxen, and for the treading of lesser cattle.

ECCLESIASTES 7:6

6 For as the crackling of thorns under a pot, so is the laughter of the fool: this also is vanity.

HOSEA 2:6

6 ¶ Therefore, behold, I will hedge up thy way **with thorns**, and make a wall, that she shall not find her paths.
