If these thistles produce at a medium only 80 beads, and that each contains only 300 seeds; the first crop from these would amount to 24,000. Let these be sown, and their crop will amount to 576 million.

Sow these, and their produce will be thirteen billion, eight hundred and twenty-four million;

and a single crop from these, which is only the third year's growth, would amount to three hundred and thirty-one trillion, seven hundred and seventy-six billion;

An international team led by scientists from the Goethe University and the Biodiversity and Climate Research Centre in Frankfurt, Germany, has discovered an intense warming phase around 52 million years ago in drill cores obtained from the seafloor near Antarctica — a region that is especially important in climate research.

The study published in the journal Nature shows that tropical vegetation, including palms and relatives of today's tropical Baobab trees, was growing on the coast of Antarctica 52 million years ago. These results highlight the extreme contrast between modern and past climatic conditions on Antarctica.

The <u>Sahara</u> is the world's largest hot desert. At over (3,500,000 square miles), it covers most of Northern Africa, making it almost as large as the United States or the continent of Europe. The desert stretches from the Red Sea, including parts of the Mediterranean coasts, to the outskirts of the Atlantic Ocean. Some of the sand dunes

can reach (600 ft.) in height. Mixed in with the oceanic sands there are large rock formations, boulders, stones and pebbles.

It wasn't always a vast desolate ocean of sand; around 5,000 years ago it was a very different terrain. It was a sub-tropical paradise a lush, green wonderland of lakes, vegetation, where deer, hippos and elephants were hunted and giraffes and rhinoceros roamed the area. With a plentiful supply of food, thousands of hunter-gatherers flocked to live in this lush savannah.

These facts are evident from the discovery of hundreds of human graves and numerous <u>rock paintings</u>, depicting people hunting and even swimming. Furthermore, radar images taken by the NASA space shuttle show that beneath the sand are <u>networks of rivers</u>, once spanning the entire Sahara. North Africa was once alive with people! What happened to this lush green world?

Beneath the sands of the Sahara Desert scientists have discovered evidence of a prehistoric megalake. Formed some 250,000 years ago when the Nile River pushed through a low channel near Wadi Tushka, it flooded the eastern Sahara, creating a lake that at its highest level covered more than 42,000 square miles.

The Sahara, which covers nearly a third of Africa, was once a lush savanna, teeming with wildlife, fish-filled lakes, and ancient humans. "Between 10,500 and around 5,550 years ago, it was a good place to live," says <a href="Stefan Kröpelin">Stefan Kröpelin</a>, a geoarchaeologist at the University of Cologne in Germany, who has spent the last 30 years leading excavations in the eastern Sahara, a region that until recently has been largely unexplored.

Kröpelin and his colleague Rudolph Kuper have unearthed hundreds of geologic samples and more than 500 archaeological artifacts—everything from animal bones to cave art—at over 100 sites.

Scientists have found what might have been the ideal ancient vacation hotspot with a 74-degree Fahrenheit average temperature, alligator ancestors and palm trees. It's smack in the middle of the Arctic.

First-of-its-kind core samples dug up from deep beneath the Arctic Ocean floor show that 55 million years ago an area near the North Pole was practically a subtropical paradise, three new studies show.

The scientists say their findings are a glimpse backward into a much warmer-than-thought polar region heated by run-amok greenhouse gases that came about naturally. "Imagine a world where there are dense sequoia trees and cypress trees like in Florida that ring the Arctic Ocean

Antarctica is the coldest, most desolate place on Earth, a land of barren mountains buried beneath a two-mile thick ice cap. Freezing winds batter its shores while week-long blizzards frequently sweep its glaciers. Yet this icy vision turns out to be exceptional. For most of

the past 100 million years, the south pole was a tropical paradise, it transpires.

"It was a green beautiful place," said Prof Jane Francis, of Leeds University's School of Earth and Environment. "Lots of furry mammals including possums and beavers lived there. The weather was tropical. It is only in the recent geological past that it got so cold." As far as vacation destinations go, Antarctica isn't much. Most of its surface is covered by a layer of ice a mile thick, and it experiences the lowest temperatures ever recorded on Earth. But millions of years ago, it was a tropical paradise compared to now, at least. At that point, it was covered not by ice, but by trees, and scientists are uncovering the fossil evidence of those long-dead forests today.

IN NORTHERN ARIZONA HAVE BEEN FOUND THOUSANDS OF FOSSILS OF OYSTERS, SEA SHELLS, FISH, AND SHARKS TEETH IN THE DESERT WHICH HAS AN ELEVATION OF 4,000 FT
