The salt from the marshes and lagoons or from the rocks in the neighborhood of the Dead Sea easily acquires a stale or alkaline taste, because of its mixture with gypsum, etc. It is then literally "good for nothing" but to be thrown away and trampled underfoot

When treaties or alliances were made, salt was employed to symbolize that the terms would be preserved for a long time. Babylonian, Persian, Arabic and Greek contexts all testify to this symbolic usage.

In the Bible, likewise, the covenant between the Lord and Israel is identified as a covenant of salt, a long preserved covenant.

Allies entering into such an agreement would generally share a communal meal in which salted meat was featured. Thus the use of salt in the sacrifices was an appropriate reminder of the covenant relationship.

#### LEVITICUS 2:13

13 And every oblation of thy meat offering shalt thou season with salt; neither shalt thou suffer the salt of the covenant of thy God to be lacking from thy meat offering: with all thine offerings thou shalt offer salt.

#### NUMBERS 18:19

19 All the heave offerings of the holy things, which the children of Israel offer unto the LORD, have I given thee, and thy sons and thy daughters with thee, by a statute for ever: it is a covenant of salt for ever before the LORD unto thee and to thy seed with thee.
