JOHN 4:16

BRIGHTNESS: GREEK LEXICON -- STRONG'S NUMBER 541
apaugasma {ap-ow'-gas-mah}
reflected brightness, used of Christ in that he perfectly reflects the majesty of God, radiance, shining forth, of a light coming from a luminous body. Out-ricing.

the instrument used for engraving or carving, the exact expression (the image) of any person or thing, precise reproduction in every respect, i.e facsimile.
