Here, as I've often said, I believe, in the church here, 111-37 there's a--a roll here like; in here lives mortal beings. And each one is in this great conglomeration of gaiety, of blackness and darkness. Mortals live in here. Now, they are either influenced from this a-way or from that way. You cannot be here a spiritual being, sinner or saint, without having an influence from the underworld or from the above world. If you're influenced from here, you're from above. But if you're wicked, and hypocritical, and indifferent, your celestial body is down here, regardless of how much you think it's up there; because the fruit that you bear before people proves where you're from. ROMANS 15:13

13 ¶ Now the God of hope **fill you** with all **joy** and **peace in believing**, that ye may abound in hope, through the <u>*POWER</u> of the Holy Ghost.

POWER: GREEK LEXICON -- STRONG'S NUMBER 1411 dunamis {doo'-nam-is}

might, strength power, ability, inherent power, power residing in a thing by virtue of its nature, or which a person or thing exerts and puts forth, moral power and excellence of soul

EPHESIANS 6:13

13 Wherefore take unto you the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand.

EPHESIANS 6:14

14 Stand therefore, having your loins girt about with truth, and having on the breastplate of righteousness;

The *girdle*, or *sash*, was always with the ancients an important part of their dress, in war as well as in peace. They wore loose, flowing robes; and it became necessary to gird them up when they travelled, or ran, or laboured.

The girdle was often highly ornamented, and was the place where they carried their money, their sword, their pipe, their writing instruments, etc.

The" girdle" was designed to keep every part of the armour in its place, and to gird the soldier on every side.

EPHESIANS 6:14

14 Stand therefore, having your loins girt about with truth, and having on the breastplate of righteousness;

The word here rendered "breastplate" (Lat., *lorica*,) or **<u>coat of mail</u>**; the armor that covered the body from the

neck to the thighs, and consisted of two parts, one covering the front and the other the back.

It was made of rings, or in the form of scales, or of plates, so fastened together that they would be flexible, and yet guard the body from a sword, spear, or arrow.

EPHESIANS 6:15

15 And your feet shod with the preparation of the gospel of peace;

The Greek noun for preparation is hetoimasia (het-oy-masee'-ah). This word appears often in the N.T in its verb form of "prepare" or "be ready".

The original noun form literally denotes preparedness (the state of being prepared) and has the general meaning of readiness.

GENESIS 5:24

24 And Enoch **walked** with God: and he was not; for God took him.

GENESIS 6:9

9 These are the generations of Noah: Noah was a just man and perfect in his generations, and Noah **walked** with God.

GENESIS 13:16

16 And I will make thy seed as the dust of the earth: so that if a man can number the dust of the earth, then shall thy seed also be numbered.

GENESIS 13:17

17 Arise, **walk through the land** in the length of it and in the breadth of it; for I will give it unto thee.
