The *girdle*, or *sash*, was always with the ancients an important part of their dress, in war as well as in peace. They wore loose, flowing robes; and it became necessary to gird them up when they travelled, or ran, or laboured.

The girdle was often highly ornamented, and was the place where they carried their money, their sword, their pipe, their writing instruments, etc.

The " girdle" was designed to keep every part of the armour in its place, and to gird the soldier on every side.

EPHESIANS 6:14

14 Stand therefore, having your loins girt about with truth, and having on the breastplate of righteousness;

EPHESIANS 6:15

15 And your feet shod with the preparation of the gospel of peace;

The Greek noun for preparation is hetoimasia (het-oy-mas-ee'-ah). This word appears often in the N.T in its verb form of "prepare" or "be ready".

The original noun form literally denotes preparedness (the state of being prepared) and has the general meaning of readiness.
