An abstract of title, or title abstract, briefly summarizes the various activities affecting ownership of a parcel of land. When a person or business agrees to purchase real estate, that person or business arranges for an examination of the history of the property's title. This examination is known as a title search. A title search is conducted to determine that the seller of the property in fact owns the property and has a free-and-clear title. A free-and-clear title has no clouds on it, which means that no person or business other than the seller has an interest in, or claim to, the property.

A TITLE SEARCH

A title search is an examination of all public records pertaining to the property. The search will include a "chain of title" which reviews the history of ownership starting with the current owner and going back typically 50 years. In addition, the search will reveal any title-related problems with the property and report all publicly recorded liens and encumbrances against the property. When a search is complete, the information is gathered on a commitment document for title insurance. This document shows any defects to the property that would be listed as exceptions to the policy as well as requirements necessary to be resolved before the policy can be issued.

CLEAR TITLE

A clear title to property is one that clearly states any obligation in the deed to the property. It reveals no breaks in the chain of legal ownership. After the records of the property have been traced and the title has been found clear, it is sometimes guaranteed, or insured.

three evangelists who have mentioned the transfiguration.

The transfiguration was designed to furnish

proof to them that the Messiah would certainly appear in glory, and to give them a

view of him as coming to reign which would never fade from their memory.

Apparently the Transfiguration was regarded by Christ Himself

as in some sense the coming of the Son of man.

from the bright cloud which overshadowed Jesus, Moses, and Elijah and was a symbol

of the glory and presence of God, as the cloud in the tabernacle and temple were, or

from heaven, the habitation of the holiness and glory of God, and where he displays the

glory of his being and perfections; or from himself, who is the God and Father of glory,

and is glorious in himself, in all his attributes and works.

In the Book of Genesis, God "walked" with His people (Gen 5:22,24; 6:9); but in Exodus, He decided to "dwell" with His people (Ex 25:8). God dwelt in the tabernacle (Ex 40:34-38) until Israel's sins caused "the glory to depart" (1 Sam 4). Then God dwelt in

the temple (1 Kings 8:1-11); but alas, again Israel sinned and the glory departed (Ezek 10:18-19). God's next dwelling place was the body of Christ (John 1:14), which men took and nailed to a cross. Today, through His Spirit, God dwells in the church, the temple of God. God does not dwell in man-made temples, including church buildings (Acts 7:48-50). He dwells in the hearts of those who have trusted Christ (1 Cor 6:19-20), and in the church collectively (Eph 2:20-22).

The foundation for this church was laid by the Apostles and New Testament prophets. Jesus Christ is the Foundation (1 Cor 3:11) and the Chief Cornerstone (Ps 118:22; Isa 8:14). The cornerstone binds the structure together, Jesus Christ has united Jews and Gentiles in the church. This reference to the temple

would be meaningful to both the Jews and the Gentiles in the **Ephesian church: the Jews would** think of Herod's temple in Jerusalem, and the Gentiles would think of the great temple of Diana. Both temples were destined to be destroyed, but the temple Christ is building will last forever. "I will build My church" (Matt 16:18). The Holy Spirit builds His temple by taking dead stones out of the pit of sin (Ps 40:2), giving them life, and setting them lovingly into the temple of God (1 Peter 2:5). This temple is "fitly framed together" as the body of Christ (Eph 2:21; 4:16), so that every part accomplishes the purpose God has in mind.

As you look back over this chapter, you cannot help but praise God for what He, in His grace, has done for sinners. Through Christ, He has

raised us from the dead and seated us on the throne. He has reconciled us and set us into His temple. Neither spiritual death nor spiritual distance can defeat the grace of God! But He has not only saved us individually, He has also made us a part of His church collectively. What a tremendous privilege it is to be a part of God's eternal program!

Church at Ephesus completely formed, as to every external thing, prays that God may

come down and dwell in it.

THAT YE, BEING ROOTED AND GROUNDED IN LOVE

Here is a double metaphor; one taken from agriculture, the other, from architecture. As

trees, they are to be rooted in love, this is the soil in which their souls are to grow;

into the infinite love of God their souls by faith are to strike their roots, and from this

love derive all that nourishment which is essential for their full growth, till they have

the mind in them that was in Jesus, or, as it is afterwards said, till they are filled with all

the fullness of God. As a building, their foundation is to be laid in this love. God so

loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, etc. Here is the ground on

which alone the soul, and all its hopes and expectations, can be safely founded. This is

a foundation that cannot be shaken; and it is from this alone that the doctrine of

redemption flows to man, and from this alone has the soul its form and comeliness.

In this, as its proper soil, it grows. On this, as its only foundation, it rests.

And His love for them is apart from HUMAN MERIT for it says that the purpose of God stands in election which is exactly opposite to works or anything man has in himself. Because "BEFORE THE CHILDREN WERE BORN" He had ALREADY said, "Jacob have I loved, but Esau have I hated."

Loved; chosen. --Hated; rejected.

Esau seems to have never cared for God at all. He had no crime; but he certainly had no grace. There is not

a prayer, nor any recognition of the fatherhood or the sovereignty of the Almighty. His "birthright" is little

or nothing to him; and a present gratification comes before any future advantage.

GENESIS 29:29

29 And Laban gave to Rachel his daughter Bilhah his handmaid to be her maid.

GENESIS 29:30

30 And he went in also unto Rachel, and he loved also Rachel more than Leah, and served with him yet seven other years.

But God put him over all Egypt in

order to carry out His own purpose and plan.

men first harden their own hearts by sinning, as Pharaoh did; what God does,

is by leaving them to the hardness of their hearts, denying them that grace which only

can soften them, and which he is not obliged to give, and therefore does them no

injustice in withholding it from them

mercy on whom he will have mercy, and whom he will he hardeneth

by judicially abandoning them to the hardening influence of sin itself

PSALM 81:11

11 But my people would not hearken to my voice; and Israel would none of me.
