GETTING IN THE SPIRIT 32

<u>JOHN 3:19</u>

19 And this is the condemnation, that light is come into the world, and men loved darkness rather than light, because their deeds were evil.

JOHN 3:20

20 For every one that doeth evil hateth the light, neither cometh to the light, lest his deeds should be reproved.

<u>JOHN 3:21</u>

21 But he that doeth truth cometh to the light, that his deeds may be made manifest, that they are wrought in God.

<u>JOHN 3:21</u>

21 But he that **doeth truth** cometh to the light, that his deeds may be made manifest, **that they are wrought in God.**

PROVERBS 4:18

18 But the path of the just is as the shining light, that shineth more and more unto the perfect day.

DANIEL 12:3

3 And they that be wise shall shine as the brightness of the firmament; and they that turn many to righteousness as the stars for ever and ever.

MATTHEW 13:41

41 The Son of man shall send forth his angels, and they shall gather out of his kingdom all things that offend, and them which do iniquity;

MATTHEW 13:42

42 And shall cast them into a furnace of fire: there shall be wailing and gnashing of teeth.

MATTHEW 13:43

43 Then shall the righteous shine forth as the sun in the kingdom of their Father. Who hath ears to hear, let him hear.

II CORINTHIANS 3:17

17 Now the Lord is that Spirit: and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty.

II CORINTHIANS 3:18

18 But we all, with ***OPEN** face beholding as in a ***GLASS** the glory of the Lord, are changed into the same image from glory to glory, even as by the Spirit of the Lord.

OPEN: GREEK LEXICON -- STRONG'S NUMBER 343 anakalupto {an-ak-al-oop'-to} to unveil or uncover (by drawing back a veil)

GLASS: GREEK LEXICON -- STRONG'S NUMBER 2734 katoptrizomai {kat-op-trid'-zom-ahee} to show in a mirror, to look at one's self in a mirror, to behold one's self in a mirror.

ASSIMILATION: the process of becoming a part, or making someone become a part, of a group, country, society, etc.:

I JOHN 3:2

2 Beloved, now are we the sons of God, and it doth not yet appear what we shall be: but we know that, when he shall appear, we shall be like him; for we shall see him as he is.

I JOHN 3:3

3 And every man that hath this hope in him purifieth himself, even as he is pure.

<u>JOHN 18:37</u>

37 Pilate therefore said unto him, Art thou a king then? Jesus answered, Thou sayest that I am a king. To this end was I born, and for this cause came I into the world, that I should bear witness unto the truth. **Every one <u>that is of the truth</u> heareth my voice.**

<u>I JOHN 1:5</u>

5 ¶ This then is the message which we have heard of him, and declare unto you, that God is light, and in him is no darkness at all.

I JOHN 1:6

6 If we say that we have fellowship with him, and walk in darkness, we lie, and do not the truth:

I JOHN 1:7

7 But if we **walk in the light, as he is in the light**, we have fellowship one with another, and the blood of Jesus Christ his Son cleanseth us from all sin.

The Greek pronoun for "one another" (allelon) refers to the two parties (God and the Christian)

I JOHN 2:6

6 He that saith he abideth in him ought himself also so to walk, **even as he walked**.

MATTHEW 7:21

21 ¶ Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; **but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven**.

MATTHEW 7:22

22 Many will say to me in that day, Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in thy name? and in thy name have cast out devils? and in thy name done many wonderful works?

<u>MATTHEW 7:23</u>

23 And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you: depart from me, ye that work iniquity.

JOHN 14:21

21 He that hath my commandments, and **keepeth them**, he it is that loveth me: and he that loveth me shall be loved of my Father, and I will love him, and will manifest myself to him.

I JOHN 2:4

4 He that saith, I know him, **and keepeth not his commandments**, is a liar, and the truth is not in him.

I JOHN 2:5

5 But whoso **keepeth his word**, in him verily is the love of God perfected: hereby know we that we are in him.

EPHESIANS 5:13

13 But all things that are reproved are made manifest **by the light**: for whatsoever doth make manifest **is light**.

<u>JOHN 5:33</u>

33 Ye sent unto John, and he bare witness unto the truth.

JOHN 5:34

34 But I receive not testimony from man: but these things I say, that ye might be saved.

<u> JOHN 5:35</u>

35 **He was a burning and a shining light**: and ye were willing for a season to rejoice in his light.

History:

From the worn-out undergarments of the cohanim they made wicks, and with them they lit the menorahs; and there was not a courtyard in Jerusalem that was not lit up by the light of the Beit-HaSho'evah [festivities]. Pious men and men of good deeds would dance around [the menorahs] with lit torches in their hands, singing songs and praises, while the Levites played harps, lyres, cymbals, trumpets and innumerable other musical instruments...."

<u>JOHN 8:12</u>

12 ¶ Then spake Jesus again unto them, saying, **I am the light of the world:** he that **followeth me** shall not walk in darkness, but shall have the light of life.

<u> JOHN 8:8</u>

8 And again he stooped down, and wrote on the ground.

<u>JOHN 8:9</u>

9 And they which heard it, being convicted by their own conscience, went out one by one, beginning at the eldest, even unto the last: and Jesus was left alone, and the woman standing in the midst.

JOHN 8:10

10 When Jesus had lifted up himself, and saw none but the woman, he said unto her, Woman, where are those thine accusers? hath no man condemned thee?

JOHN 8:11

11 She said, No man, Lord. And Jesus said unto her, Neither do I condemn thee: go, and sin no more.

JOHN 8:12

12 ¶ Then spake Jesus again unto them, saying, I am the light of the world: he that followeth me shall not walk in darkness, but shall have the light of life.

"The people that walked in darkness have seen a great light; they that dwell in the land of the shadow of death, upon them hath the light shined" (Isa 9:2).

9 Jesus answered, Are there not twelve hours in the day? If any man walk in the day, he stumbleth not, because he seeth the light of this world.

JOHN 12:35

35 Then Jesus said unto them, Yet a little while is the light with you. Walk while ye have the light, lest darkness come upon you: for he that walketh in darkness knoweth not whither he goeth.

36 While ye have light, believe in the light, that ye may be the children of light. These things spake Jesus, and departed, and did hide himself from them.

JOHN 12:46

46 I am come a light into the world, that whosoever believeth on me should not abide in darkness.

ACTS 26:16

16 But rise, and stand upon thy feet: for I have appeared unto thee for this purpose, to make thee a minister and a witness both of these things which thou hast seen, and of those things in the which I will appear unto thee;

ACTS 26:17

17 Delivering thee from the people, and from the Gentiles, unto whom now I send thee,

ACTS 26:18

18 To open their eyes, and to turn them from darkness to light, and from the power of Satan unto God, that they may receive forgiveness of sins, and inheritance among them which are sanctified by faith that is in me.

ROMANS 13:12

12 The night is far spent, the day is at hand: let us therefore cast off the works of darkness, and let us put on the armour of light.

II CORINTHIANS 4:3

3 But if our gospel be hid, it is hid to them that are lost:

II CORINTHIANS 4:4

4 In whom the god of this world hath blinded the minds of them which believe not, lest the light of the glorious gospel of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine unto them.

II CORINTHIANS 4:5

5 For we preach not ourselves, but Christ Jesus the Lord; and ourselves your servants for Jesus' sake.

II CORINTHIANS 4:6

6 For God, who commanded the light to shine out of darkness, hath shined in our hearts, to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ.

EPHESIANS 5:8

8 For ye were sometimes darkness, but now are ye light in the Lord: walk as children of light:

EPHESIANS 5:13

13 But all things that are reproved are made manifest by the light: for whatsoever doth make manifest is light.

EPHESIANS 5:14

14 Wherefore he saith, Awake thou that sleepest, and arise from the dead, and Christ shall give thee light.

COLOSSIANS 1:12

12 ¶ Giving thanks unto the Father, which hath made us meet to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in light:

I THESSALONIANS 5:5

5 Ye are all the children of light, and the children of the day: we are not of the night, nor of darkness.

<u>I TIMOTHY 6:15</u>

15 Which in his times he shall shew, who is the blessed and only Potentate, the King of kings, and Lord of lords;

<u>I TIMOTHY 6:16</u>

16 Who only hath immortality, dwelling in the light which no man can approach unto; whom no man hath seen, nor can see: to whom be honour and power everlasting. Amen.

II TIMOTHY 1:10

10 But is now made manifest by the appearing of our Saviour Jesus Christ, who hath abolished death, and hath brought life and immortality to light through the gospel:

I PETER 2:9

9 But ye are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, an holy nation, a peculiar people; that ye should shew forth the praises of him who hath called you out of darkness into his marvellous light:

II PETER 1:19

19 ¶ We have also a more sure word of prophecy; whereunto ye do well that ye take heed, as unto a light that shineth in a dark place, until the day dawn, and the day star arise in your hearts:
