18 Also day by day, from the first day unto the last day, he read in the book of the law of God. And they kept the feast seven days; and on the eighth day was a solemn assembly, according unto the manner.

NEHEMIAH 9:1

1 ¶ Now in the twenty and fourth day of this month the children of Israel were assembled with fasting, and with sackclothes, and earth upon them.

NEHEMIAH 9:2

2 And the seed of Israel **separated themselves** from all strangers, and stood and **confessed their sins**, and the iniquities of their fathers.
