Boaz meaning "fleetness", was a wealthy Bethlehemite, a kinsman to Elimelech the husband of Naomi. He married Ruth, and redeemed the estate of her deceased husband Mahlon.

Boaz meaning "in him is strength", strength of riches, power, virtue, and grace;
