REVELATION 16:12

12 ¶ And the sixth angel poured out his vial upon the great river Euphrates; and the water thereof was dried up, that the way of the kings of the east might be prepared.

REVELATION 16:13

13 And I saw three unclean spirits like frogs come out of the mouth of the dragon, and out of the mouth of the beast, and out of the mouth of the false prophet.

REVELATION 16:14

14 For they are the spirits of devils, working miracles, which go forth unto the kings of the earth and of the whole world, to gather them to the battle of that great day of God Almighty.

REVELATION 16:15

15 Behold, I come as a thief. Blessed is he that watcheth, and keepeth his garments, lest he walk naked, and they see his shame.

JOEL 3:2

JOEL 3:11

11 Assemble yourselves, and come, **all ye heathen**, and gather yourselves together round about: thither cause thy mighty ones to come down, O LORD.

JOEL 3:12

12 Let the heathen be wakened, and come up to the valley of Jehoshaphat: for there will I sit to judge all the heathen round about.

ZECHARIAH 14:1

1 ¶ Behold, the day of the LORD cometh, and thy spoil shall be divided in the midst of thee.

ZECHARIAH 14:2

2 **For I will gather all nations against Jerusalem to battle;** and the city shall be taken, and the houses rifled, and the

women ravished; and half of the city shall go forth into captivity, and the residue of the people shall not be cut off from the city.

ZECHARIAH 14:3

3 Then shall the LORD go forth, and fight against those nations, **as when he fought in the day of battle.**

EXODUS 14:22

22 And the children of Israel went into the midst of the sea upon the dry ground: and the waters were a wall unto them on their right hand, and on their left.

EXODUS 14:23

23 And the Egyptians pursued, and went in after them to the midst of the sea, even all Pharaoh's horses, his chariots, and his horsemen.

EXODUS 14:24

24 And it came to pass, that in the morning watch the LORD looked unto the host of the Egyptians through the pillar of fire and of the cloud, and troubled the host of the Egyptians,

EXODUS 14:25

25 And took off their chariot wheels, that they drave them heavily: so that the Egyptians said, Let us flee from the face of Israel; **for the LORD fighteth for them against the Egyptians.**

EXODUS 14:26

26 And the LORD said unto Moses, Stretch out thine hand over the sea, that the waters may come again upon the Egyptians, upon their chariots, and upon their horsemen.

EXODUS 14:27

27 And Moses stretched forth his hand over the sea, and the sea returned to his strength when the morning appeared; and the Egyptians fled against it; and the LORD overthrew the Egyptians in the midst of the sea.

EXODUS 14:28

28 And the waters returned, and covered the chariots, and the horsemen, and all the host of Pharaoh that came into the sea after them; there remained not so much as one of them.

EXODUS 14:29

29 But the children of Israel walked upon dry land in the midst of the sea; and the waters were a wall unto them on their right hand, and on their left.

EXODUS 14:30

30 Thus the LORD saved Israel that day out of the hand of the Egyptians; and Israel saw the Egyptians dead upon the sea shore.

DEUTERONOMY 1:30

30 The LORD your God which goeth before you, **he shall fight for you**, according to all that he did for you in Egypt before your eyes;

DEUTERONOMY 1:31

31 And in the wilderness, where thou hast seen how that the LORD thy God bare thee, as a man doth bear his son, in all the way that ye went, until ye came into this place.

DEUTERONOMY 20:3

3 And shall say unto them, Hear, O Israel, ye approach this day unto battle against your enemies: let not your hearts faint, fear not, and do not tremble, neither be ye terrified because of them;
