MOVING FROM SHILOH

JOSHUA 18:1

1 ¶ And the whole congregation of the children of Israel assembled together at Shiloh, and set up the tabernacle of the congregation there. And the land was subdued before them.

I SAMUEL 3:21

21 And the LORD appeared again **in Shiloh**: for the LORD revealed himself to Samuel **in Shiloh** by the word of the LORD.

GENESIS 8:20

20 ¶ And Noah builded an altar unto the LORD; and took of every clean beast, and of every clean fowl, and offered burnt offerings on the altar.

GENESIS 12:7

7 And the LORD appeared unto Abram, and said, Unto thy seed will I give this land: and there **builded he an altar unto the LORD**, who appeared unto him.

GENESIS 12:8

8 And he removed from thence unto a mountain on the east of Bethel, and pitched his tent, having Bethel on the west, and Hai on the east: and there he builded an altar unto the LORD, and called upon the name of the LORD.

GENESIS 13:18

18 Then Abram removed his tent, and came and dwelt in the plain of Mamre, which is in Hebron, and built there an altar unto the LORD.

GENESIS 22:5

5 And Abraham said unto his young men, Abide ye here with the ass; and I and the lad will go yonder and **WORSHIP**, and come again to you.

GENESIS 22:9

9 And they came to the place which God had told him of; and Abraham **built an altar there**, and laid the wood in order, and bound Isaac his son, and laid him on the altar upon the wood.

GENESIS 26:23

23 And he went up from thence to Beersheba.

GENESIS 26:24

24 And the LORD appeared unto him the same night, and said, I am the God of Abraham thy father: fear not, for I am with thee, and will bless thee, and multiply thy seed for my servant Abraham's sake.

GENESIS 26:25

25 **And he builded an altar there**, and called upon the name of the LORD, and pitched his tent there: and there Isaac's servants digged a well.

GENESIS 28:17

17 And he was afraid, and said, How dreadful is this place! this is none other but the house of God, and this is **the gate of heaven**.

GENESIS 28:18

18 And Jacob rose up early in the morning, and took the stone that he had put for his **pillows**, and set it up for **a pillar**, and poured oil upon the top of it.

GENESIS 28:19

19 And he called the name of that place Bethel: but the name of that city was called Luz at the first.

GENESIS 28:20

20 And Jacob vowed a vow, saying, If God will be with me, and will keep me in this way that I go, and will give me bread to eat, and raiment to put on,

GENESIS 28:21

21 So that I come again to my father's house in peace; then shall the LORD be my God:

GENESIS 28:22

22 And this stone, which I have set for a pillar, **shall be God's house**: and of all that thou shalt give me I will surely give the tenth unto thee.

GENESIS 35:6

6 ¶ So Jacob came to Luz, which is in the land of Canaan, that is, Bethel, he and all the people that were with him.

GENESIS 35:7

7 **And he built there an altar,** and called the place Elbethel: because there God appeared unto him, when he fled from the face of his brother.

II SAMUEL 6:12

12 ¶ And it was told king David, saying, The LORD hath blessed the house of Obededom, and all that pertaineth unto him, because of the ark of God. So David went and brought up the ark of God from the house of Obededom into the city of David **with gladness**.

II SAMUEL 6:13

13 And it was so, that when they that bare the ark of the LORD had gone six paces, he sacrificed oxen and fatlings.

II SAMUEL 6:14

14 And David danced before the LORD with all his might; and David was girded with a linen ephod.

II SAMUEL 6:15

15 So David and all the house of Israel brought up the ark of the LORD with shouting, and with the sound of the trumpet.

II SAMUEL 6:16

And as the ark of the LORD came into the city of David, Michal Saul's daughter looked through a window, and saw king David leaping and dancing before the LORD; and she despised him in her heart.

II SAMUEL 6:17

17 And they brought in the ark of the LORD, and set it in his place, in the midst of the tabernacle that David had pitched for it: and David offered burnt offerings and peace offerings before the LORD.

I CHRONICLES 22:5

5 And David said, Solomon my son is young and tender, and the house that is to be builded for the LORD **must be exceeding magnifical, of fame and of glory throughout all countries:** I will therefore now make preparation for it. So David prepared abundantly before his death.

I CHRONICLES 29:1

1 ¶ Furthermore David the king said unto all the congregation, Solomon my son, whom alone God hath chosen, is yet young and tender, and the work is great: **for the palace is not for man, but for the LORD God**.

I CHRONICLES 29:2

2 Now I have prepared **with all my might** for the house of my God the gold for things to be made of gold, and the silver for things of silver, and the brass for things of brass, the iron for things of iron, and wood for things of wood; onyx stones, and stones to be set, glistering stones, and of divers colours, and all manner of precious stones, and marble stones in abundance.

I CHRONICLES 29:3

3 Moreover, because I have set my affection to the house of my God, I have of mine own proper good, of gold and silver, which I have given to the house of my God, over and above all that I have prepared for the holy house,

I CHRONICLES 29:4

4 Even three thousand talents of gold, of the gold of Ophir, and seven thousand talents of refined silver, to overlay the walls of the houses withal:

I CHRONICLES 29:5

5 The gold for things of gold, and the silver for things of silver, and for all manner of work to be made by the hands of artificers. And who then is willing to consecrate his service this day unto the LORD?

I CHRONICLES 29:6

6 Then the chief of the fathers and princes of the tribes of Israel, and the captains of thousands and of hundreds, with the rulers of the king's work, **offered willingly**,

I CHRONICLES 29:7

7 And gave for the service of the house of God of gold five thousand talents and ten thousand drams, and of silver ten thousand talents, and of brass eighteen thousand talents, and one hundred thousand talents of iron.

I CHRONICLES 29:8

8 And they with whom precious stones were found gave them to the treasure of the house of the LORD, by the hand of Jehiel the Gershonite.

I CHRONICLES 29:9

9 Then the people rejoiced, for that they offered willingly, because with perfect heart they offered willingly to the LORD: and David the king also rejoiced with great joy.

II CHRONICLES 5:11

11 ¶ And it came to pass, when the priests were come out of the holy place: (for all the priests that were present were sanctified, and did not then wait by course:

II CHRONICLES 5:12

Asaph, of Heman, of Jeduthun, with their sons and their brethren, being arrayed in white linen, having cymbals and psalteries and harps, stood at the east end of the altar, and with them an hundred and twenty priests sounding with trumpets:)

II CHRONICLES 5:13

13 It came even to pass, as the trumpeters and singers were as one, to make one sound to be heard in praising and thanking the LORD; and when they lifted up their voice with the trumpets and cymbals and instruments of musick, and praised the LORD, saying, For he is good; for his mercy endureth for ever: that then the house was filled with a cloud, even the house of the LORD;

II CHRONICLES 5:14

14 So that the priests could not stand to minister by reason of the cloud: for the glory of the LORD had filled the house of God.

PSALM 78:59

59 When God heard this, he was wroth, and greatly abhorred Israel:

PSALM 78:60

60 So that he forsook the tabernacle of Shiloh, the tent which he placed among men;

PSALM 78:61

61 And delivered his strength into captivity, and his glory into the enemy's hand.

12 But go ye now unto my place which was **in Shiloh**, where **I set my name at the first**, and see what I did to it for the wickedness of my people Israel.
