# <u>JOHN 9:1</u>

1 ¶ And as Jesus passed by, he saw a man which was blind from his birth.

# <u>JOHN 9:2</u>

2 And his disciples asked him, saying, Master, who did sin, this man, or his parents, that he was born blind?

# <u> JOHN 9:3</u>

3 Jesus answered, Neither hath this man sinned, nor his parents: **but that the works of God should be made manifest in him**.

# <u>JOHN 9:6</u>

6 When he had thus spoken, he spat on the ground, and made clay of the spittle, and he anointed the eyes of the blind man with the clay,

# <u> JOHN 9:7</u>

7 And said unto him, Go, wash in the pool of Siloam, (which is by interpretation, Sent.) He went his way therefore, and washed, and came seeing.

# <u>JOHN 9:8</u>

8 ¶ The neighbours therefore, and they which before had seen him that he was blind, said, Is not this he that sat and begged?

## <u>JOHN 9:9</u>

9 Some said, This is he: others said, He is like him: but he said, I am he.

## <u>JOHN 9:10</u>

10 Therefore said they unto him, How were thine eyes opened?

## <u>JOHN 9:11</u>

11 He answered and said, **A man that is called Jesus made clay**, and anointed mine eyes, and said unto me, Go to the pool of Siloam, and wash: and I went and washed, and I received sight.

# <u>JOHN 9:12</u>

12 Then said they unto him, Where is he? He said, I know not.

## <u> JOHN 9:13</u>

13 ¶ They brought to the Pharisees him that aforetime was blind.

## <u> JOHN 9:14</u>

14 And it was the sabbath day when Jesus made the clay, and opened his eyes.

## <u> JOHN 9:15</u>

15 Then again the Pharisees also asked him how he had received his sight. He said unto them, He put clay upon mine eyes, and I washed, and do see.

## <u> JOHN 9:16</u>

16 Therefore said some of the Pharisees, This man is not of God, because he keepeth not the sabbath day. **Others said**, How can a man that is a sinner do such miracles? **And there was a division among them.** 

## <u>JOHN 9:17</u>

17 They say unto the blind man again, **What sayest thou** of him, that he hath opened thine eyes? He said, <u>HE IS A</u> <u>PROPHET.</u>

## <u>JOHN 9:18</u>

18 But the Jews did not believe concerning him, **that he had been blind**, and received his sight, until they called the parents of him that had received his sight.

# <u>JOHN 9:19</u>

19 And they asked them, saying, Is this your son, who ye say was born blind? how then doth he now see?

# <u> JOHN 9:20</u>

20 His parents answered them and said, We know that this is our son, and that he was born blind:

# <u>JOHN 9:21</u>

21 But by what means he now seeth, **we know not; or who hath opened his eyes, we know not:** he is of age; ask him: he shall speak for himself.

# JOHN 9:22

22 These words spake his parents, **because they feared the Jews:** for the Jews had agreed already, that if any man did confess that he was Christ, **he should be put out of the synagogue.** 

# <u>JOHN 9:23</u>

23 Therefore said his parents, He is of age; ask him.

# <u>JOHN 9:24</u>

24 Then again called they the man that was blind, and said unto him, Give God the praise: **we know that this man is a sinner**.

# <u>JOHN 9:25</u>

25 He answered and said, Whether he be a sinner or no, I know not: **one thing I know, that, whereas I was blind, now I see**.

# <u>JOHN 9:26</u>

26 Then said they to him again, What did he to thee? how opened he thine eyes?

# <u> JOHN 9:27</u>

27 He answered them, **I have told you already,** and ye did not hear: wherefore would ye hear it again? will ye also be his disciples?

#### JOHN 9:28

28 Then they reviled him, and said, Thou art his disciple; but we are Moses' disciples.

## <u>JOHN 9:29</u>

29 We know that God spake unto Moses: as for this fellow, we know not from whence he is.

## <u>JOHN 9:30</u>

30 The man answered and said unto them, **Why herein is a marvellous thing,** that ye know not from whence he is, and yet he hath opened mine eyes.

## <u>JOHN 9:31</u>

31 Now we know that God heareth not sinners: but if any man be a worshipper of God, and doeth his will, him he heareth.

## <u>JOHN 9:32</u>

32 Since the world began was it not heard that any man opened the eyes of one that was born blind.

#### <u>JOHN 9:33</u>

33 If this man were not of God, he could do nothing.

## <u>JOHN 9:34</u>

34 They answered and said unto him, Thou wast altogether born in sins, and dost thou teach us? **And they cast him out.** 

# <u>JOHN 9:35</u>

35 ¶ Jesus heard that they had cast him out; and when he had found him, he said unto him, Dost thou believe on the Son of God?

# <u> JOHN 9:36</u>

36 He answered and said, Who is he, Lord, that I might believe on him?

# <u> JOHN 9:37</u>

37 And Jesus said unto him, Thou hast both seen him, and it is he that talketh with thee.

# <u>JOHN 9:38</u>

38 And he said, Lord, I believe. And he worshipped him.
