BESTOW: GREEK LEXICON -- STRONG'S NUMBER 4060 peritithemi {per-ee-tith'-ay-mee} to place around, set about; to put on a garment; to put or bind a thing around another

I CORINTHIANS 12:24

24 For our comely parts have no need: but God hath ***TEMPERED** the body together, having given more abundant honour to that part which lacked:

TEMPERED: GREEK LEXICON -- STRONG'S NUMBER 4786 sugkerannumi {soong-ker-an'-noo-mee} to mix together, commingle; to unite: caused the several parts to combine into an organic structure, which is the body, to unite one thing to another

I CORINTHIANS 12:25

25 That there should be no ***SCHISM** in the body; but that the members should have the same care one for another.

SCHISM: GREEK LEXICON -- STRONG'S NUMBER 4978 schisma {skhis'-mah} division, a rent, metaph. a division, dissension

ROMANS 16:17

17 ¶ Now I beseech you, brethren, mark them which cause **divisions and offences** contrary to the doctrine which ye have learned; **and avoid them**.

I CORINTHIANS 12:26

26 And whether one member suffer, all the members suffer with it; or one member be honoured, all the members rejoice with it.

II CORINTHIANS 10:15

15 Not boasting of things **without our measure**, that is, of **other men's labours;** but having hope, when your faith is increased, that we shall be enlarged by you according to **our rule abundantly**,

16 To preach the gospel in the regions beyond you, and not to boast in another man's **<u>*LINE</u>** of things made ready to our hand.
