To refine gold, heat must be applied to force the impurities to the surface, the impurities are called Dross. The temperature must reach 2,102 degrees Fahrenheit

As the Dross or impurities rise, they are removed, and more heat is applied. This process continues and continues, and continuous heat is applied and re-applied, until the gold is pure.

The refiner knows the gold is pure when he looks into the gold and sees his clear reflection.

In Malachi 3:2-3 it states, "But who may abide the day of his coming? and who shall stand when he appeareth? for he is like a refiner's fire, and like fullers' soap: 3 And he shall sit as a refiner and purifier of silver: and he shall purify the sons of Levi, and purge them as gold and silver, that they may offer unto the LORD an offering in righteousness."
