#### **GETTING IN THE SPIRIT 115**

### **I CORINTHIANS 12:14**

14 For the body is not one member, but many.

# **I CORINTHIANS 12:15**

15 If the foot shall say, Because I am not the hand, I am not of the body; is it therefore not of the body?

### **I CORINTHIANS 12:16**

16 And if the ear shall say, Because I am not the eye, I am not of the body; is it therefore not of the body?

### I CORINTHIANS 12:17

17 If the whole body were an eye, where were the hearing? If the whole were hearing, where were the smelling?

### **I CORINTHIANS 12:18**

18 But now hath God **set** the members every one of them in the body, **as it hath pleased him.** 

## **ROMANS 12:5**

5 So we, being many, are one body in Christ, and every one members one of another.

## **I CORINTHIANS 12:12**

12 ¶ For as the body is one, and hath many members, and all the members of that one body, being many, are one body: so also is Christ.

## **I CORINTHIANS 12:27**

27 ¶ Now ye are the body of Christ, and members in particular.

## **I CORINTHIANS 12:18**

18 But now hath God <u>SET</u> the members every one of them in the body, as it hath pleased him.

### **JOHN 15:16**

16 Ye have not chosen me, but I have chosen you, and **ordained** you, that ye should go and bring forth fruit, and that your fruit should remain: that whatsoever ye shall ask of the Father in my name, he may give it you.

### I CORINTHIANS 12:11

11 But all these worketh that one and the selfsame Spirit, dividing to every man severally **as he will**.

### **I CORINTHIANS 12:28**

28 And God hath <u>SET</u> some in the church, first apostles, secondarily prophets, thirdly teachers, after that miracles, then gifts of healings, helps, governments, diversities of tongues.

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519-50 Like someone said to me not long ago, said, "The Lord called me to preach."

I said, "Well, then preach." See? And so he--he... I really think it's so... Satan, if he can just get somebody as to act like that <u>AND THEN DECEIVE THEM</u>, that's just what he wants to do. Then the whole world points their finger right there. Somebody thinks they have a gift of speaking in tongues and interpretation; some has the gift of Divine healing; some has these things like... Sometimes they're mistaken in those things. See? And sometimes they think they haven't got it when they have. So it's very tricky.

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519-52 So always do this, brethren, whenever you feel that you're supposed to do a thing, **first find out if it's Scriptural for you to do it,** if it's in the Scriptures, not just wrote in one place, **but I mean completely Scriptural through the Bible for you to do it, your position**, say if you'd be an evangelist, pastor, teacher, prophet, whatever that God might've called you to be. You see? Or if you have the gift of tongues, gift of

interpretation, gift of any--any kind of the nine spiritual gifts in the church, and the four spiritual offices of the church, any position, first see if God called.

Then, usually, way I watch it for myself, just... This is me. I watch the nature of the person and see what kind of a gift that they're professing. See, God will work with His creature the way He's made him. See? He'll make a creature...

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520-54 If you see him real flighty and going on, you--and he says, "The Lord called me for such and such a--to be a pastor."

Now, a pastor can't be a flighty person. A pastor's solid, sound. See?

"God called me to be a teacher." And watch him how he interprets the Word. See? **He gets It all mixed up and everything, then you can tell.** See?

But then, the thing to do, your position is usually known whether you can do it or not.

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520-57 Now, when God called me to be an evangelist, **I** wanted to be a pastor. And I thought staying at home here would just be fine.......

......And my calling was an evangelist. The morning... Laying right here at this cornerstone, if we could burst in there tonight, you'll see a flyleaf off of my Bible where He told me to be an evangelist. See? And I wasn't a successful pastor, never would be, because I haven't got the patience and what it takes to be a pastor. See? So therefore, if I tried to pastor, I would just be as far out as a pastor is trying to be an evangelist. See what I mean? You can see the way the Lord calls you, what your position is in the Body......

### **EXODUS 31:1**

1 ¶ And the LORD spake unto Moses, saying,

### **EXODUS 31:2**

2 See, I have called by name Bezaleel the son of Uri, the son of Hur, of the tribe of Judah:

### **EXODUS 31:3**

3 And I have filled him with the spirit of God, in wisdom, and in understanding, and in knowledge, **and in all manner of workmanship**,

### **EXODUS 31:4**

4 To devise **cunning works**, to work in gold, and in silver, and in brass,

### **EXODUS 31:5**

5 And in cutting of stones, to set them, and in carving of timber, to work in **all manner of workmanship.** 

### **EXODUS 31:6**

6 And I, behold, I have given with him Aholiab, the son of Ahisamach, of the tribe of Dan: **and in the hearts of all that are wise hearted I have put wisdom**, that they may make all that I have commanded thee;

gold, silver, brass, blue, purple, scarlet, fine linen, rams' skins dyed red, what we call badgers' skins, oil, spices, incense, onyx stones, and other stones,

They must also have brought looms, spinning wheels, instruments for cutting precious stones, anvils, hammers, furnaces, melting-pots, with a vast variety of tools for the different artists employed on the work of the tabernacle, smiths, joiners, carvers, gilders, etc.

## **EXODUS 35:30**

30 ¶ And Moses said unto the children of Israel, See, the LORD hath called by name Bezaleel the son of Uri, the son of Hur, of the tribe of Judah;

### **EXODUS 35:31**

31 And he hath filled him with the spirit of God, in wisdom, in understanding, and in knowledge, and in all manner of workmanship;

### **EXODUS 35:32**

32 And to devise <u>curious works</u>, to work in **gold**, and in **silver**, and in **brass**,

### **EXODUS 35:33**

33 And in the cutting of stones, to set them, and in carving of wood, **to make any manner of cunning work.** 

### **EXODUS 35:34**

34 And he hath put in his heart that he may <u>TEACH</u>, both he, and Aholiab, the son of Ahisamach, of the tribe of Dan.

# **EXODUS 38:23**

23 And with him was Aholiab, son of Ahisamach, of the tribe of Dan, an engraver, and a cunning workman, and an embroiderer in blue, and in purple, and in scarlet, and fine linen.

## **EXODUS 35:35**

35 Them hath he filled with wisdom of heart, to work all manner of work, of the engraver, and of the cunning workman, and of the embroiderer, in blue, and in purple, in scarlet, and in fine linen, and of the weaver, even of them that do any work, and of those that devise cunning work.

## **EXODUS 35:25**

25 And all the women that were **wise hearted** did spin with their hands, and brought that which they had spun, both of blue, and of purple, and of scarlet, and of fine linen.

### **EXODUS 35:26**

26 And all the women whose heart stirred them up in wisdom spun goats' hair.

### **EXODUS 36:1**

1 ¶ Then wrought Bezaleel and Aholiab, and every wise hearted man, in whom the LORD put wisdom and understanding to know how to work all manner of work for the service of the sanctuary, according to all that the LORD had commanded.

### **EXODUS 36:2**

2 And Moses called Bezaleel and Aholiab, and every wise hearted man, in whose heart the LORD had put wisdom, even every one whose heart stirred him up to come unto the work to do it:

**GOLD** 29 talents 730 shekels = 1 1/4 tons

**SILVER** 100 talents 1,775 shekels = 4 1/4 tons

**BRASS** 70 talents 2,400 shekels = 4 tons

A talent of gold was about 120 pounds, a talent of silver about 100 pounds, a shekel was one-half ounce.

Adding to this the cost of the wood, fabrics, priestly garments, precious stones, it has been estimated to be valued at \$30 million without labor.

### **I KINGS 7:13**

13 ¶ And king Solomon sent and fetched Hiram out of Tyre.

### I KINGS 7:14

14 He was a widow's son of the tribe of Naphtali, and his father was a man of Tyre, a worker in brass: and he was filled with wisdom, and understanding, and cunning to work all works in brass. And he came to king Solomon, and wrought all his work.

### **I KINGS 7:15**

15 For he cast two pillars of brass, of eighteen cubits high apiece: and a line of twelve cubits did compass either of them about.

### **I KINGS 7:16**

16 And he made two chapiters of molten brass, to set upon the tops of the pillars: the height of the one chapiter was five cubits, and the height of the other chapiter was five cubits:

## **I KINGS 7:17**

17 And nets of checker work, and wreaths of chain work, for the chapiters which were upon the top of the pillars; seven for the one chapiter, and seven for the other chapiter.

## **I KINGS 7:18**

18 And he made the pillars, and two rows round about upon the one network, to cover the chapiters that were upon the top, with pomegranates: and so did he for the other chapiter.

## **I KINGS 7:19**

19 And the chapiters that were upon the top of the pillars were of lily work in the porch, four cubits.

## **I KINGS 7:20**

20 And the chapiters upon the two pillars had pomegranates also above, over against the belly which was by the network: and the pomegranates were two hundred in rows round about upon the other chapiter.

### I KINGS 7:21

21 And he set up the pillars in the porch of the temple: and he set up the right pillar, and called the name thereof Jachin: and he set up the left pillar, and called the name thereof Boaz.

#### **I KINGS 7:22**

22 And upon the top of the pillars was lily work: so was the work of the pillars finished.

### **I KINGS 7:23**

23 And he made a molten sea, ten cubits from the one brim to the other: it was round all about, and his height was five cubits: and a line of thirty cubits did compass it round about.

Excluding the bronze, and using the average current price of gold, the gold alone of Solomon's temple would have been an astonishing \$194,404,500,000.

The silver would have been \$22,199,076,000. Added together, the gold and silver used along in Solomon's Temple was worth \$216,603,576,000.

## I CORINTHIANS 12:19

19 And if they were all one member, where were the body?

## **I CORINTHIANS 12:20**

20 But now are they many members, yet but one body.

## **I CORINTHIANS 12:21**

21 And the eye cannot say unto the hand, I have no need of thee: nor again the head to the feet, I have no need of you.

### **I CORINTHIANS 12:22**

Nay, much more those members of the body, which seem to be more feeble, are \*NECESSARY:
